The sleady rise in the senior citizen population will also increase demand on health care services, she said. The committee will study the costs of hiring additional nurses and replacing some health unit branch office equipment.

Meanwhile, committee chairman Walter Mulkewich told reporters that the search for a new medical officer of health is proving fruitless, despite recent interviews with six potential candidates for the \$41,000 per year job.
