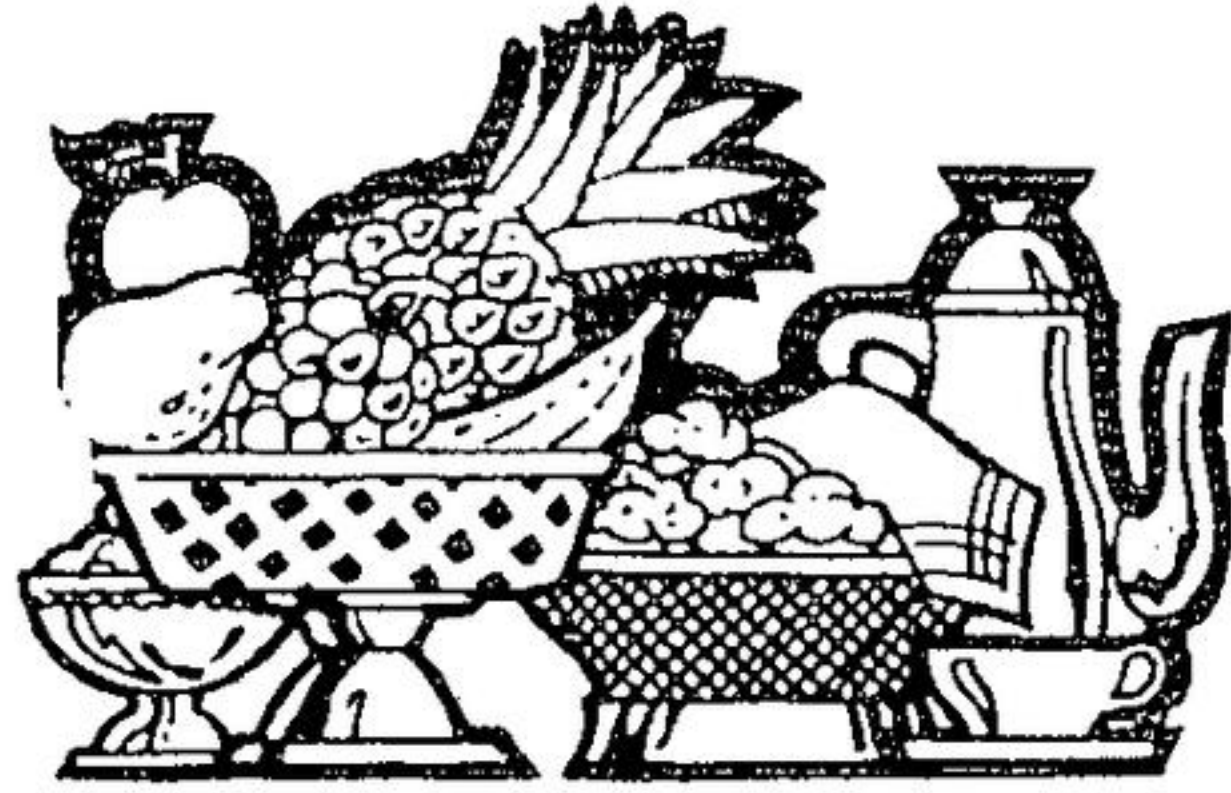

PM's plan a one-man show: MP

A constitution should be drafted on the terms of all Canadians, and not just Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau, Brampton-Georgetown MP John McDermid said last week.

Reacting to the prime minister's nation-wide address Thursday night, he said in an interview it "smacks of a one-man show".

Trudeau told television viewers he wants to patriate the British North America Act and also make amendments. A document outlining the proposal will be presented in the House of Commons this week. Amendments would include a charter of rights, minority language and education rights and equalization payments by wealthier provinces to poorer ones.

John McDermid said he wants to look at details before making specific comments. "I'm in favor of patriation there's no question of that," he said. "But really it (bringing home the constitution) is a symbolic thing. It won't change high unemployment, interest rates or inflation."

The Conservative MP said in an earlier interview following the collapse of the first ministers' conference on constitutional change, it's "frightening" that a federal government which doesn't have broad support across the country, "would opt for unilateral action."

"Our concern is one of poisoning the atmosphere more than it's poisoned now in relations between the federal government and provinces," he said.

Prime Minister Trudeau, the MP said, is misleading Canadians when he says the constitution was put together by foreigners.

"In fact it is a Canadian document drafted by Canadians," Mr. McDermid said.

Mr. McDermid returned to Brampton last week after spending time in Western Canada as part of a federal task force studying employment opportunities.

He described the mood in both Manitoba and Saskatchewan as cautious. "They all want the constitution back but don't trust the prime minister," he said.

Smoke detectors vital for fire safety

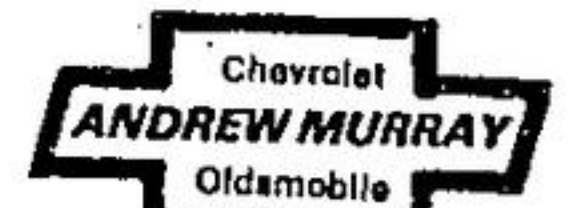
To do their job properly though, smoke detectors must be installed properly and they must be maintained. An alarming number of people have their detectors mounted in a poor location or have failed to replace the batteries in their detectors. Testing detectors is also important and should be done monthly.

The majority of people in our town have installed smoke detectors and are fire safety-conscious. However, few families have taken the time to sit down as a family and discuss what to do when a fire does strike. Escape planning should be an integral part of overall fire safety.

The Fire Department can provide information in this area and have a filmstrip presentation available for people to view in their own home. Also the Department offers home inspections.
