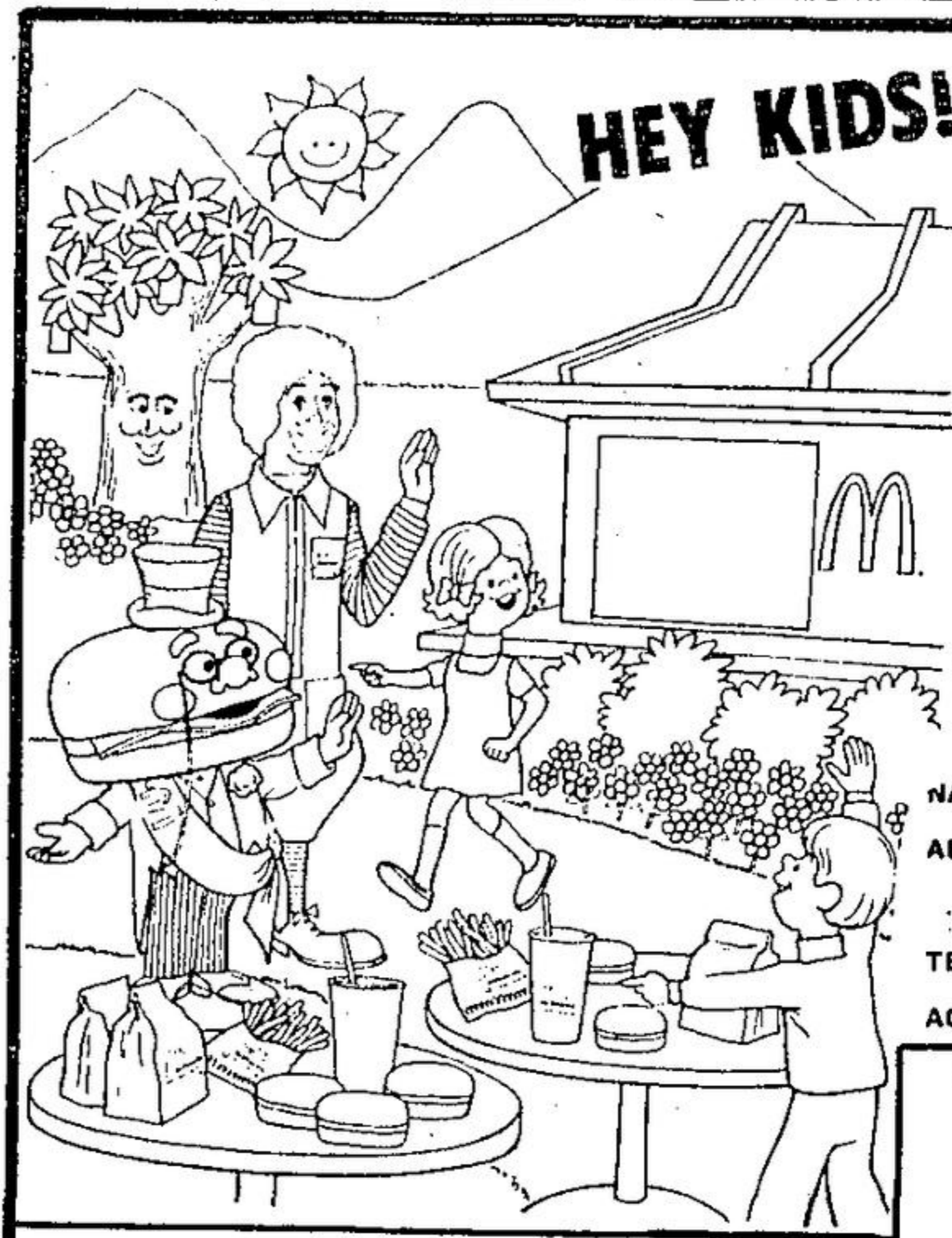

Hostel opening delayed

The opening of Halton Women's Place has been delayed until mid-October because of unfinished renovations.

The hostel, the region's first hostel for abused women and their children, is located in the old Hugh Street police station in Milton. The police station has been re-located in the former Health Unit building near the old jail.

Director Loretta Costigane said the contractor still has some major renovations to complete, and staff and volunteers will have to do some cleaning before the centre can be opened.

The centre will be the only service of its kind in the region and will offer abused wives and their children a place to stay until they can decide what they want to do.

HOME OF THE WEEK

DRAMATIC TUDORESQUE TWO-STOREY

All of the romance and tradition of our cultural heritage is embodied in this impressively large Tudoresque design, which is ideally suited to the large family which has acquired a wide frontage on the stately exterior are complemented by the large dormer windows of the upper story and the double, paneled and wrought-iron bound main entrance - all of which detail creates the imposing look of an English country estate home. Almost 3,000 square feet of finished floor area is available on the two levels, with a full basement for additional space for future development of recreational and other active facilities.

The double-doored entry opens into a large, dramatically vaulted foyer, which is flanked by double guest closets, and which contains an impressive circular planter or fountain, according to individual family preference. A semi-circular winding staircase to the upper level is just to the right of the reception foyer.

From the foyer traffic moves naturally to the right to the sunken living room, which features a wide window with diamond panes, on either side, and a back-to-back cantilevered-hearth masonry fireplace which is shared by the family room.

Country-style living is best realized in the bay-windowed kitchen, breakfast nook and family room. The U-configuration kitchen features a central work island which contains the range, vegetable chopping block, waste sink and abundant pot and serving tray storage. The large adjacent breakfast nook separates from the kitchen via work counter area, which latter could easily be developed as a snack bar counter for those who prefer. A sliding glass walk-out opens onto a large split level rear patio, for convenient access to outdoor dining in fine weather. An optional spindle screen wall divides the breakfast nook and the sunken family room, which latter shares the back-to-back fireplace with the living room, and which also has sliding glass doors to the rear patio. Everything is within visual range of the kitchen for instant supervision of smaller children.

A large, bay-windowed, formal dining room is easily accessible from both the kitchen and the entrance foyer, and a three-piece vanity bath with shower is adjacent to both the kitchen and the large utility room.

A double full garage is sunken by two risers from the main level of the home. Access to the utility room provides a mud room facility, as does rearward access to a covered porch.

The upstairs floor plan is equally luxurious and convenient as down. Four bedrooms, the two front-facing of which have interesting alcoves formed by the dormer windows. All four have excellent natural lighting and generous closet storage facilities. The very large master bedroom has a full walk-in closet and a four piece ensuite bathroom with two vanity sinks and tub. The walk-in closet contains a laundry chute to the utility room in the main floor.

The semi-circular staircase, open to the entrance foyer, creates a free-form platform and window seat, which provides a lounge area for the master bedroom.

A full basement contains abundant space for the future development of additional bedrooms, wet bar, recreation room and workshop, and still leaves abundant space for a generous storage and workshop area.

Plans for design No. 77-2813 may be purchased either by the single set, at a cost of \$85.00 for the first set and \$15.00 for each additional set, or by the package. A five-set plan package, also including the first set, is economically priced at \$135.00, and an eight-set package, also including the first set, is only \$175.00.
