City houses a good investment

Herald Special The three-bedroom, detached home in the inner-city area will become real estate's hottest housing commodity during the 1980's, according to a Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation market specialist.

Tony Weilman, the federal agency's director of market analysis and forecasting, says a shift in buyer preference away from the suburbs and back to the city proper is becoming increasingly evident as people become more sensitive to transportation and

energy costs. "But the suburbs will continue to absorb most of the new housing built simply because land is not available in the city's inner areas." he

"The growing attraction of the older, central locations to more affluent home buyers is apparent in the prices of homes being offered for sale. The asking prices for dwellings in the inner areas are climbing much faster than those in the suburbs."

accommodation strengthens. Wellman expects more and more builders will become involved in the purchase and modernization of older homes for re-sale to middle and higher-income familles. But the process will bring

As the demand for inner-city

mixed blessings. "It will do much to upgrade the oldest portion of our urban housing stock. However, it means as well that we could lose our supply of older city-core housing that, for decades, has met the bulk of the housing demand for those in the lower-income brackets." "In fact," he claims, "it is

very likely that as the back-to-

the-city trend develops among

the more wealthy buyers

lower-income families could be forced out to the suburbs in their search for affordable .. accommodation." Wellman says that demographic as well as energy conservation pressures will have a dramatic impact on the demand, production and

marketing of housing during the new decade. "Nationally, we are unlikely to see the sort of price escalation we experienced in housing during the early 70's," he feels. The reason is that Canada is "moving down the other side of the baby boom that pushed housing production and price increases to record levels in the first half of the last

decade." Declining requirements for new housing generally will mean starts across Canada can be expected to drop from an average of about 235,000 in the 1976-9 period to 166,000 in 1989. This compares with annual starts averaging 233,000 throughout the 1970's. "With builders competing in that kind of a shrinking market, we can expect house price increases will be held very close to the rate of

inflation." A good part of the new housing produced in the 80's will be needed to allow the children of the baby boom and their familles to upgrade their accommodation. "When these families bought their first homes, they were looking for economical "starter units" transitional housing that would give them some hedge against inflation.

"Now these families are

reaching their maximum size

and earning potential and they are ready to shift up to homes that are more in line with their affluence and mode of living." Wellman says the fact that these families are smaller, on the average, than ever before means there will be little demand for large, luxurious homes in the 80's. The increasing prevalence of childless families with two incomes may, however, create a specialized market for expensive, smaller, customized housing units for couples

building careers rather than

families.

"On balance, I expect to see some shaving off of demand for homes in both the top and lowest price ranges. Demand for new houses will be concentrated very heavily on middlepriced homes - particularly three-bedroom units built on individual lots. Trends in this direction are already emerging. Even though total starts have declined for the past three years, starts of single houses have remained constant throughout the period."
