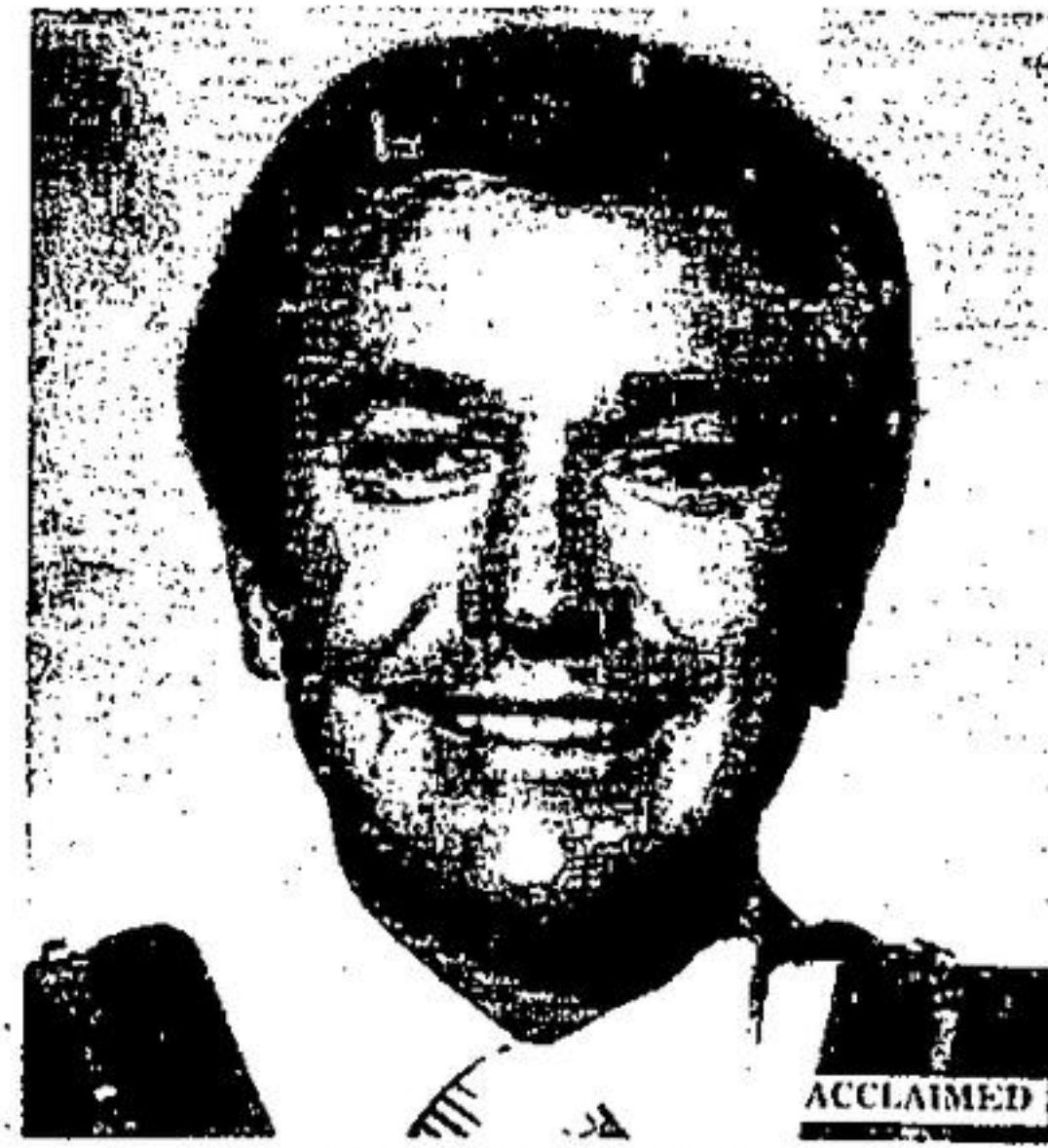

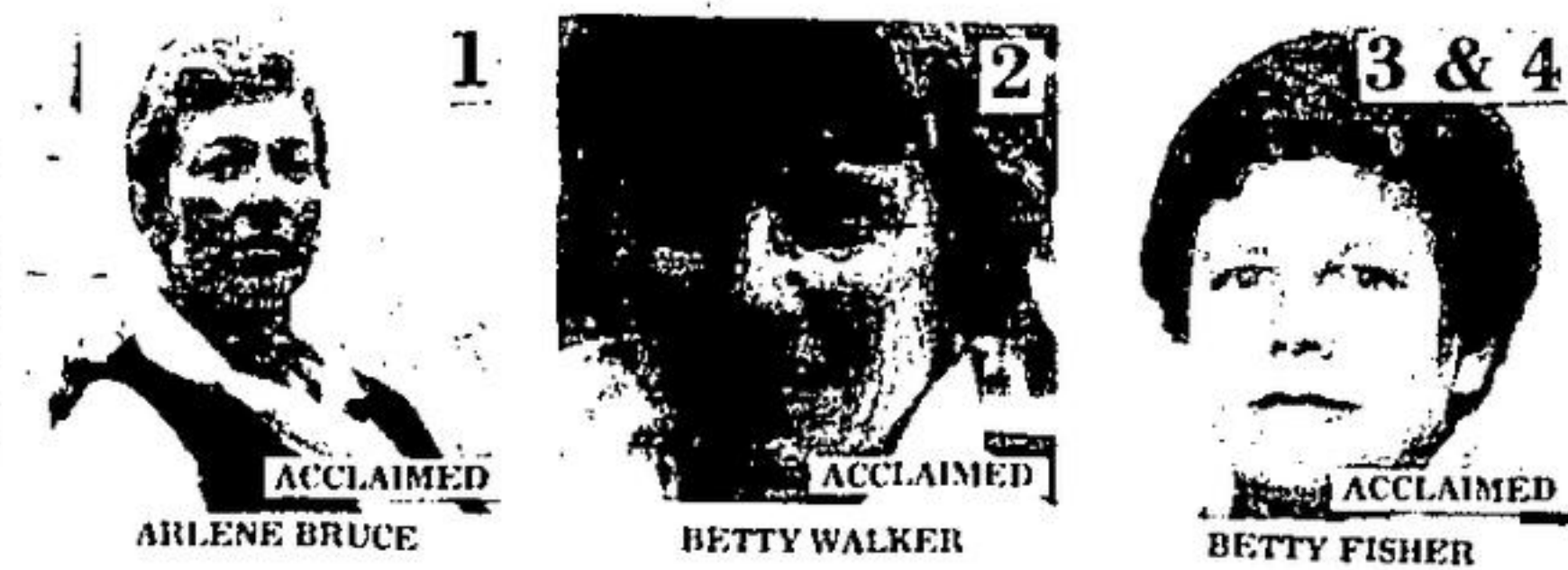

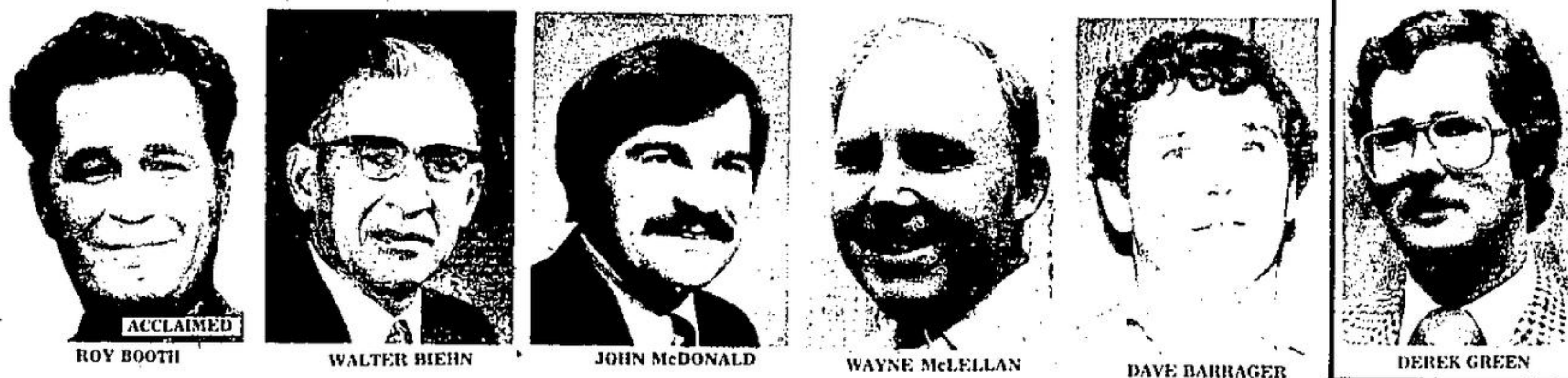

**Peel policeman joins Ward 3 race**

Halton Hills has good government, Ward 3 candidate Derek Green says, but it could be even better. Mr. Green, a constable with Peel Regional Police, is running for office for the first time against incumbent Walter Biehn and John McDonald, and challenger Dave Barrager.

Mr. Green has been a police officer for 21 years, first in England, and later with Metro police, before

joining the former Brampton force. He has been a member of the Lions Club and is active in the Canadian Cancer Society. Mr. Green said he has been concerned about a number of issues, but the "last straw" was the increase in water rates. He also thinks the west end of Ward 3, where he lives, tends to be somewhat neglected.

He is an avowed conservationist, and would like to

see programs such as Divide and Conquer expanded, with more public participation than the program now receives. "I'd like to see a big improvement in public transit in the area, especially between components of the region," Mr. Green said. "We don't even have decent transportation between the urban areas of Georgetown and Acton."

**Local businessman seeks Ward 3 seat**

Local businessman David Barrager has decided to follow in his father's footsteps and enter the political arena to challenge Walter Biehn and John McDonald for a Ward 3 (Georgetown) council seat. Mr. Barrager, owner-operator of Barrager's Laundromat and Dry Cleaners Ltd. at the corner of Windsor Road and Guelph Street, said that while he feels the present council "has been doing the job" he would "like to add something to it".

He said that friends had

urged him for two years to enter the election race, but he didn't make his decision until 5:45 Friday morning following "a sleepless night". He said he "enters the race with hopes". Mr. Barrager grew up in Georgetown and has been running the 35-year old family business for 17 years. His father, Don, was a member of the former Georgetown council during the early 1960s.

Married and the father of two children, Mr. Barrager said he plans an active campaign.

"I'm going to knock on doors and try and canvass as much of the area as possible with the time we have left," he said.
