## Better service for kids studied

The results of a region-wide study showing that 57 per cent of Halton children in need of residential care are transferred outside the region will be among topics of discussion at special, inaugural subcommittee meeting set for tomorrow (Thursday) night.

The first meeting of the Halton Children's Services Steering Group, which operates under the auspices of the regional planning department, will begin at 7:30 p.m. at regional headquarters in Oakville. On the agenda will be the report of Justine Howarth, project co-ordinator, regarding her survey of the children's services situation in Halton.

Ms. Howarth discovered that a majority of Halton children in need of residential care travel to institutions outside the region, but at the same time, the region spends less money per child than other comparable regions.

Whereas Halton spent an average of \$7.48 per child per day for residential services between Jan. 1, 1978, and Dec. 31, 1979, Ms. Howarth found, Peel's daily cost per child was \$8.31 and Hamilton-Wentworth's \$15.61. Ms. Howarth said the next step is to study the effect of long-range transportation and lower spending upon the children involved.

Ms. Howarth's study found that Halton is generally well-equipped for short-term child care, but the vast majority — some 80 per cent — must be transported up to 160 miles for long-term residential care.

Chaired by Ruth Taber, the children's services steering group invited concerned residents to join them tomorrow night in examining Metro Toronto's planning for children's services in the 1980s, covering such topics as daycare, group homes and multiple uses for schools.

## New pact set for separate teachers

Halton Separate School Board and its 400 teachers ratified a one-year contract this week which gives a 12 per cent increase to the teachers.

The new agreement, reached after a marathon bargaining session Oct. 9 with mediator David Greenspan, gives the teachers a 9.5 per cent increase on the grid with a 2.5 per cent increment. Principals received a 9 per cent increase.

The contract also gives teachers an improved dental and extended health care package although the board's share of health care premiums was frozen at 85 per cent for this contract.

The pact will cost the board \$10.2 million.

## School numbers down

While the rest of Halton region is experiencing a decline in enrolment at elementary and secondary school levels, north Halton is experiencing an increase.

In a report on enrolment in Halton schools, superintendent of finance Bruce Lindley said last week enrolment at the elementary level has declined by 433 and secondary enrolment has declined by 538.

In north Halton, however, elementary enrolment has increased by 113, and secondary enrolment by 12.

The pupil-teacher ratio at the elementary level is 21.46, but does not include 16 of the board's special education teachers. The pupil-teacher ratio at the high school level is 17.96 and at the special vocational high schools, it's 13.07.
