We will buy Canadian paper money, 1935 and prior. And paper money from all Canadian banks. We also buy U.S. and foreign paper money, both government and bank issues.

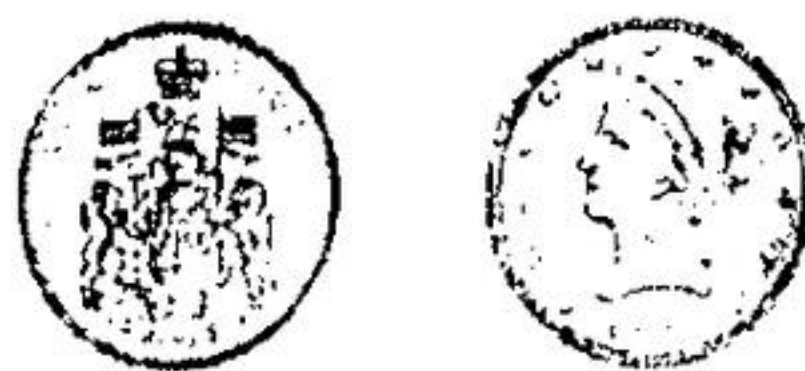

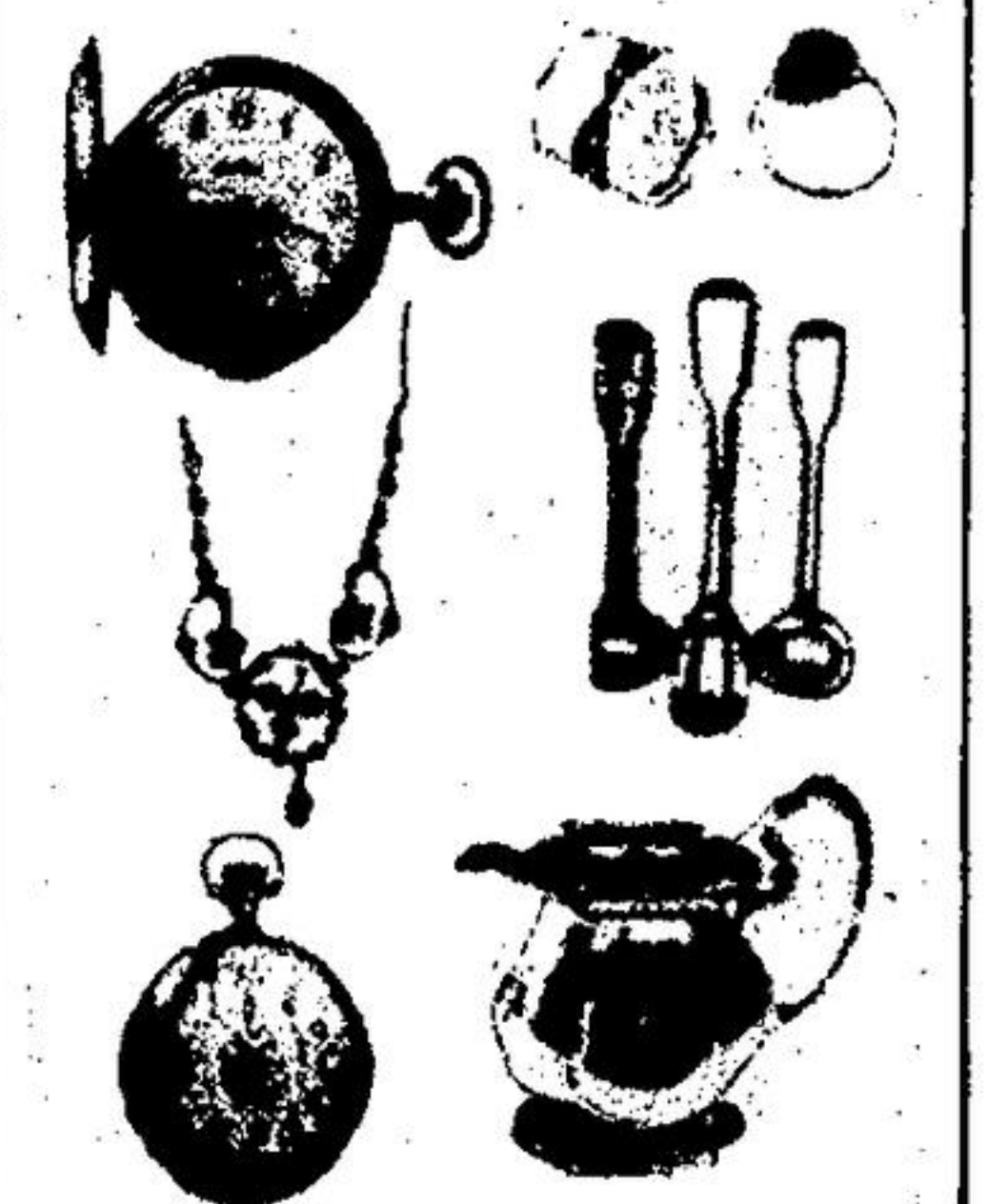
