This year's Georgetown Fair was viewed as a success, in light of increased attendance and gate receipts, when members of the Georgetown Agricultural Society met last week for their first general meeting since October.

President Herb Dolson thanked fair directors and committee members who turned out to help prepare the grounds and clean up and those who assisted on fair day. The president injured his ankle just prior to the fair and several fair officials, including secretary Denny Charles, had been hospitalized, but despite these misfortunes, all events had gone on as scheduled

Meeting in the Cedarvale Community Hall last week, reports were heard from the various committees, with · increased entries reported in the Hunters and Jumpers classes and in several livestock divisions. It was decided that the fair's prize list should be reviewed and many of the prizes increased in value for next year, the 135th anniversary of the event. It is hoped that the fair will eventually be upgraded from a Class C to a Class B fair, but this is a process which takes at least three years.

A vote of thanks was extended to Jim and Rita Barrett. newcomers to the Society, who introduced and successfully ran both a Baby Show and Little Miss Halton Hills competition. It was decided to enter a float in this year's Santa Claus parade featuring the fair queen, little Leslie Ann Staddon, and her friends.

The annual dinner of the Agricultural Society and directors will be held at Union Church Nov. 26.

The possibility of extending the fair to three days: Friday, Saturday and Sunday was also discussed.




