



Mr. Marshall worked first at Irwin and Goldham's Butcher Shop. He owned a small grocery store at the corner of King and Queen Streets in Georgetown which he sold to Norman Hill. He went to work for the. post office in 1938, and was postmaster from 1956 to 1973. He married Dorothy May Ballantine November 11, 1931

at Georgetown United Church. Mr. Marshall was a member of the Royal Canadian Postal Corporation Veterans' Association. He was a past member of the Lions Club, and a past member of the Georgetown Chamber of Commerce. He was a director of the Ontario Postmasters' Association Life

Membership from 1957 to 1965. Mr. Marshall joined the Active Canadian Postal Corporation in 1940 as a private and was promoted to Captain in June, 1944.

Mr. Marshall is survived by his wife and sons Paul Marshall and Thomas Marshall, and daughter Doris Goodlet, all of Georgetown.
