# Finances threaten hostel

The executive director of the Sheridan Youth home in Milton, that may soon be closed because of a financial dispute with the government, has accused the ministry of community and social services of "bar-gaining in poor faith."

John Cox, who heads the highly-praised juvenile detention centre, that is used extensively by Peel residents charged with the ministry with being indecisive on the issues and issuing distorting statements.

"I am getting a little fed up," said Mr. Cox. "Let's not talk about apples and oranges. Let's talk about where it's at. Why doesn't someone please tell us why they want to close us? Why doesn't someone come up with answers?"

According to Mr. Cox, the \$297,000, 1981 operation budget offered by the ministry is \$3,000 less than what the government provided this year.

However, a ministry spokesman claimed earlier that the proposed budget was six per cent more than this year's operating budget.

"At the home they had difficulty with staffing and re-scheduling," said Charlie Caudle, program supervisor for the ministry in the south-western Ontario region.

"So, we provided them with extra funding. They are including this money with last year's budget."

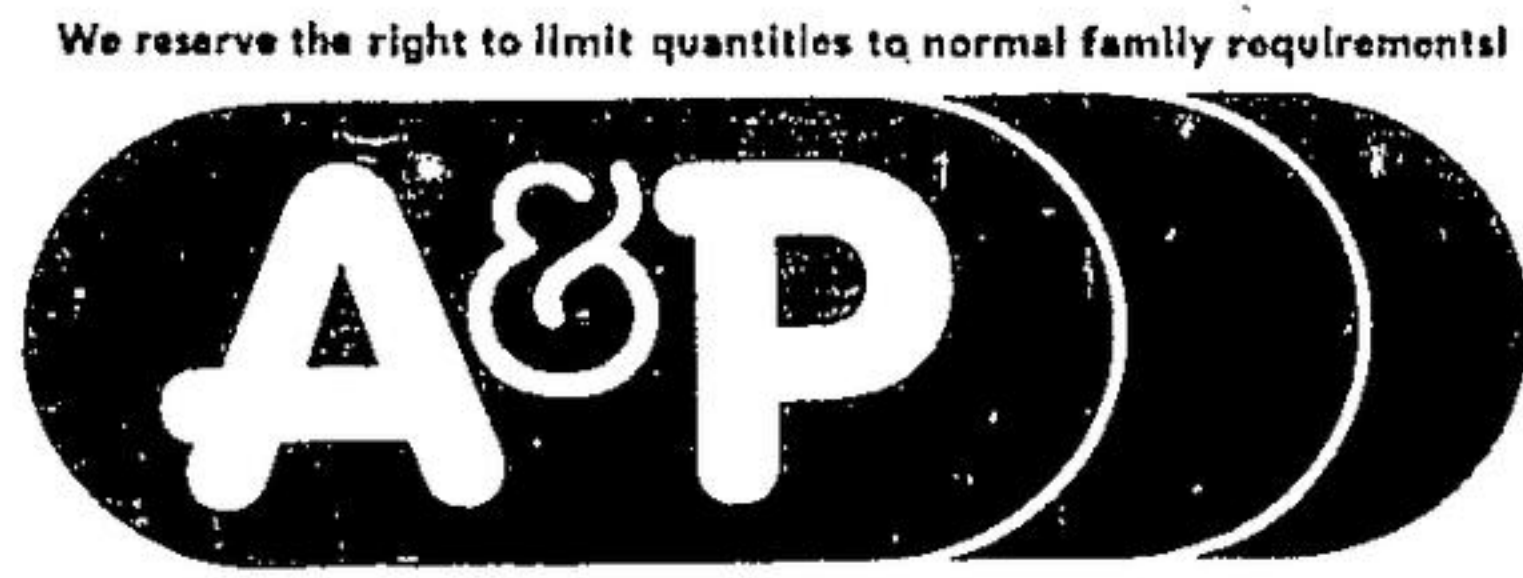
"The ministry keeps distorting statements," said Mr. Cox in response to Mr. Caudle. "And about the staffing problem it was just a simple-minded remark that was said at one of our board meetings."
