## Minister's omission irks Reed

Halton-Burlington BPP Julian Reed has criticized Ontario's minister of education, Dr. Bette Stephenson for failing to formally notify him of grants being given to schools in his riding.

Mr. Reed said that in both the granting of funds for a new separate school in Acton and the construction of a new school in Brant Hill in Burlington, the announcement came from James Snow, minister of transportation and communications, who does not represent Burlington or Acton.

Mr. Reed congratulated the parents in Acton and Brant Hill, who were directly involved in persuading the government to allocate money for schools in their area, but said he objected to the minister's failure to formally notify him, as the riding's representative.

"I realize an election is drawing near and it is always in the interest of your party to present an image that you calculate will make you look as good as possible," Mr. Reed wrote. "But it seems that, under normal circumstances, a certain dignity prevails among elected members in parliament, in the same manner as there is honor among thieves."

## Regional health officer found

Halton region's health and social services committee has chosen a new medical officer of health, ending a year-long search which followed the retirement of Georgetown doctor Joseph Chamberlain last November.

Details of the selection, made at a committee meeting two weeks ago, will not become clear until regional council sits to ratify the decision later this month.

Although the position has been filled temporarily by Burlington family physician Dr. Gordon Inglis, the health committee has had difficulty attracting qualified applicants and maintaining interest among possible candidates.

The committee has previously denied that the annual salary, reported to be about \$2,000 lower than the provincial average of \$43,000 for similar positions, has hampered efforts to fill the post and indicated it would be willing to negotiate pay with prospective candidates.
