The region has conducted \$500,000 worth of engineering studies at the site and argues that, if forced to look seriously at other locations, another \$175,000 In addition studies would have to be spent.

Progress on Site "F" has been stalled while the region and the town of Milton awalt a provincial cabinet decision on whether or not public hearings on the proposal should be held under the Environmental Assessment Act, which would force the region to consider alternative sites, or under the Environmental Protection Act in which evidence brought to the hearing deals strictly with the Tremaine-Britannia location.

Meanwhile, Site "A", a shale quarry, continues to look more promising as an alternative to the battle-scarred Site "F" proposal.

The water study payed for by National Sewer Pipe indicates that the site will be suitable for a landfilling operation, but study consultants John Cherry and Don Lush warned that a second landfill site would be unheard of unless the region checks the "leachate" flow from the present dump.

Produced by water seeping through dumpsite trash, leachate contains numerous toxic chemicals, and unless corrected the consultants warned, the problem at the region's only landfill site could last for hundreds of years. Regional solicitor Dennis

Perlin warned council two months ago that costs associated with studying alternative sites could endanger the funds available for implementing an effective re-useable trash separation program in Halton.
