Highway study due Jan. 13

Town council's public meeting on the future of the Highway 7 corridor through Georgetown has been postponed until Jan. 13. Originally scheduled for last Tuesday night's planning board session, the meeting will review recommendations from A.J. Diamond and Associates, a consulting firm hired by the town to examine problems along Guelph Street and suggest solutions. Snow forced cancellation of last week's session.

Vincent gravel sought

Pending the submission of a plan of the area to be mined, town council said Monday it will approve a wayside pit permit to allow Bot Construction of Oakville to extract 150,000 tons of gravel from the Vincent gravel pit on the Sixth Line north of the 17 Sideroad. Bot has asked for the permit to repair Highway 401 from Winston Churchill Boulevard to the Credit River on a contract from the provincial ministry of transportation and communications.

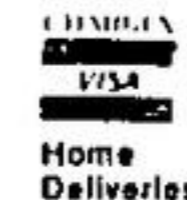

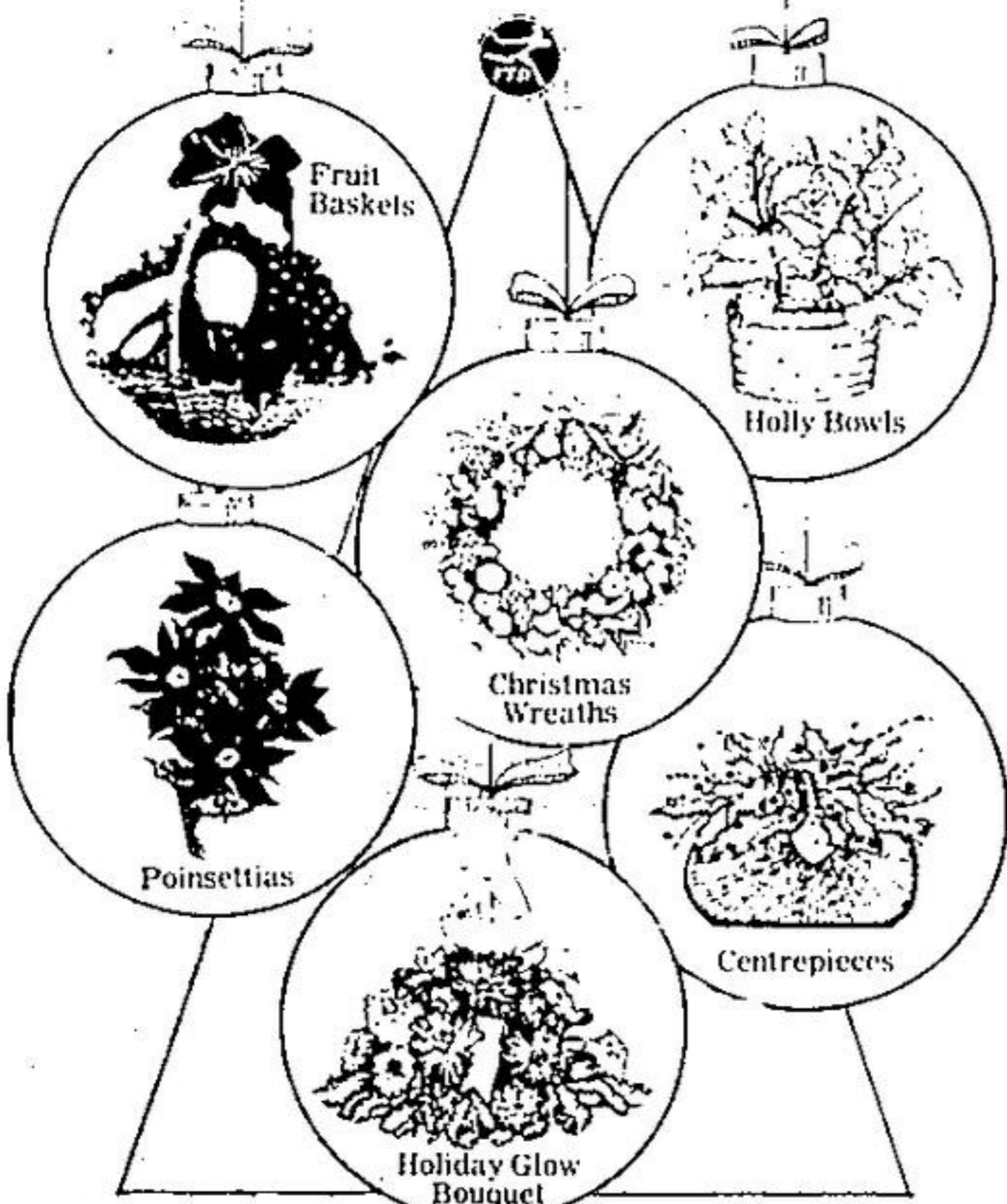

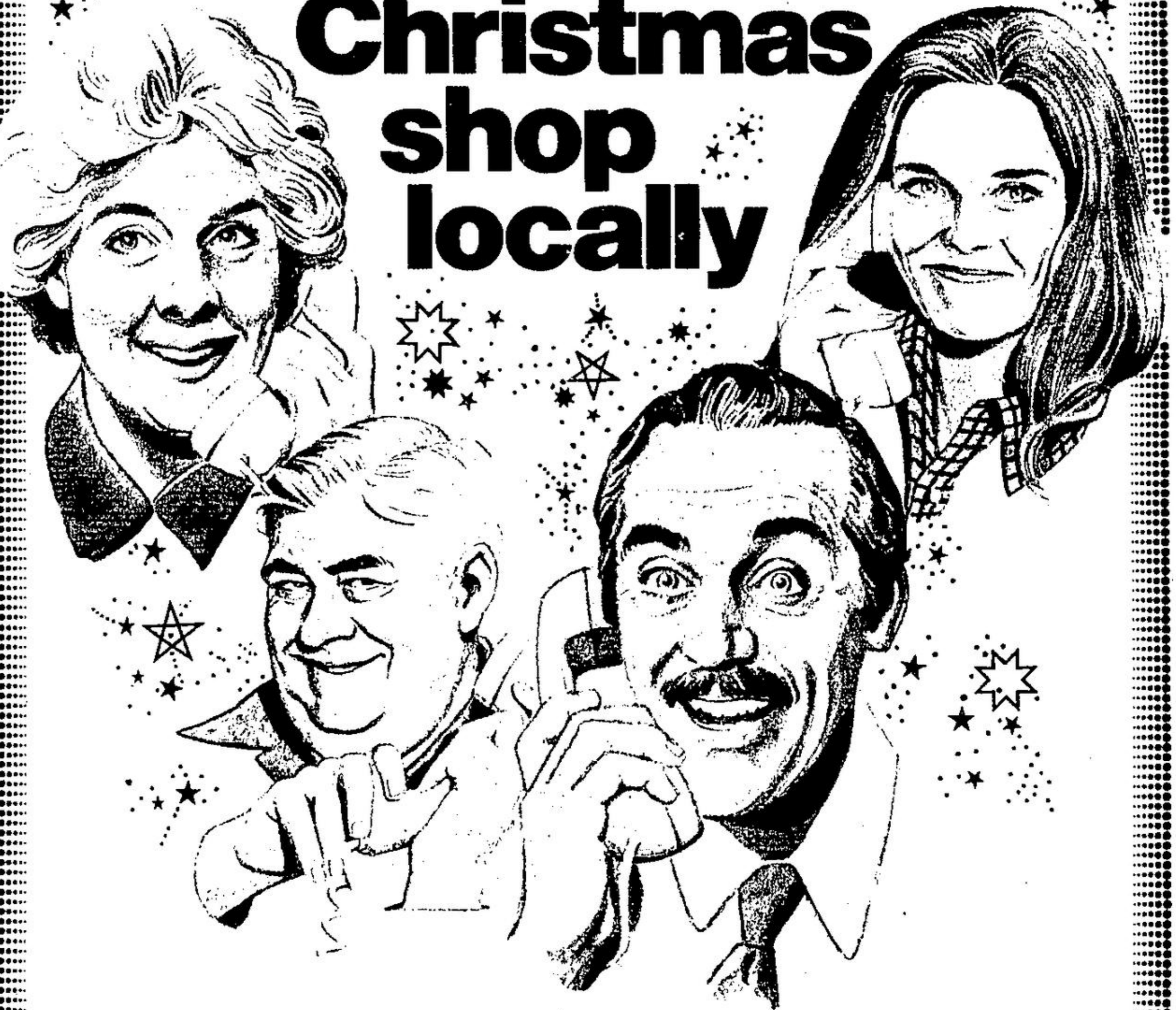
