## Fate of Hornby school topic

The Halton board of education will be deciding the future of Hornby's Sunshine School tomorrow (Thursday),

The school was built by the North Halton Association for the Mentally Retarded with public donations and government support. The school was turned over to the Halton board of education in 1969 as required by law.

The board declared the school redundant last year, and has since gone through the required process of offering the facility to various levels of government before putting it up for public sale.

Georgelown trustee Betty Fisher has made a motion to rent the school building to the North Hallon Association for the sum of \$1 per year.

## Board to appoint committee members

The Halton board of education will formalize the 1981 membership of its 12 committees at the meeting tomorrow (Thursday)

Appointments will also be made to another six committees on which the board is represented, included the Halton Salety Council, the Home and School Council and the Association of Large School Boards of Ontario,

Halton, Hills' two rookie trustees, Arlene Bruce, Ward 1, and Betty Walker, Ward 2, will have their work cut out for them. Mrs. Bruce is a member of the French Language Advisory Committee, the finance committee, the Library Relations committee and the Home and School Council.

Mrs. Walker will be on the Early School Leaving committee, the salary committee, the staff-board committee and will represent the board on a conservation committee.

Georgetown trustee Betty Fisher will represent the board on the Halton Elementary Teachers' Association P.A. committee, on the Community Schools Administration and at the Association of Large School Boards of Ontario on the curriculum committee.

## Still no word on Site 'F' hearings

Provincial environment minister Harry Parrott has yet to decide on the nature of public hearings planned to discuss a proposed 246-acre dumpsite in Milton.

Originally scheduled for Oct 15, the hearings were postponed following a ruling by Ontario Supreme Court Judge James Southey calling on the minister to determine whether the hearings should be held under the Environmental Assessment Act (EAA) which would require the region to provide additional evidence at the hearings on other proposed landfill sites, or the Environmental Protection Act (EPA) which deals only with environmental questions on the property alone.

But Christmas vacations and sessions in the legislature have prevented Mr. Parrott from keeping a promise made last fall to reach a decision on the hearings, a ministry spokesman said last week, adding that Mr. Parrott should have an unswer soon.

The town of Millon and a 500-member citizen's group opposed to the dumpsite proposed for the northwest corner of Tremaine and Britannia Roads, are hoping that under the EAA, the region would have to consider using a possible landfill site in Burlington, adjacent to the old dump on King Road.

A consultant's study on lands owned by National Sewer Pipe Ltd. has indicated that the 200-acre property would be suitable for a garbage dump, but only if leachate problems from the closed dump next to it

are corrected. Meanwhile, the region has spent over half a million dollars in engineering studies at the Milton site, and regional solicitor Dennis Perlin warned last fall that further expenses in studying other dumpsite proposals could jeopardize Halton's future solid waste management program to recycle trash for fuel.


