



## Jon wins motorcycle race

Jon Cornwell of RR1, Georgetown received 1st place at the International World of Motorcycles Jan. 24 for his 500cc Yamaha Dirt Track racing bike.

This much-modified machine was instrumental in helping Cornwell achieve the 1979 Canadian short track championship, in earning him Expert Professional status in the United States, in placing him in the "Top 10" Junior riders on the Ohio dirt tracks, and placing him fourth at the fiercely competitive Grand National Syracuse Mile 500 Invitational race last September.

The bike's success has been largely due to the cooperative

efforts of several local people. Brian Olsen of Acton who is service manager at Kelly's Motorcycles in Brampton is part owner of the machine and it's principle mechanic over the years. Dave Armstrong of Armstrong's garage on Guelph St. has lent his considerable super-tuning expertise to wringing the most horsepower out of the engine; "Robbie" of Brampton is responsible for the classic paint job that features the Canadian Maple leaf and Jim Lindsay of Auto Serv in Guelph has assisted with the tuning.

Cornwell, who will be competing in the U.S. again in 1981 as well as on the Canadian

dirt track circuit will be taking the machine to several prestigious American events where, as a first year expert, he will be pitted against the best and most experienced dirt-track racers in the world.

The season starts in February at the Houston Astrodome, moves to Florida for the Daytona series and then continues throughout the U.S. Dirt tracking in Canada starts in May and continues until late in September.

Sponsored for several years by Kelly's, Cornwell is now also receiving substantial help with his lightweight racer, a 250cc Yamaha, from Ingills Cycles in London, Ont.
