Board approves quarry's growth

An application by J.C. Duff Ltd. to expand its Fifth Line gravel quarrying operation north of Limehouse has been approved by the town planning board.

Although the board's decision awaits approval from council, members last Tuesday night tentatively endorsed the company's request for a bylaw amendment allowing more gravel to be extracted from the 200-acre Duff property at the northeast corner of the Fifth Line and 24 Sideroad.

Neighboring Fourth Line residents had expressed concern that the expanded gravel operation would increase noise and dust pollution. However, J.C. Duff Ltd. owner Mac Duff assured residents that the site is well-protected by trees and its distance from nearby homes and farms. Blasting, he added, would not be required in the extractive process.

Part of the conditions which the planning department included with its recommendation to approve Duff's application call for the company to pave part of the Fifth Line near its two entrances to the property. J.C. Duff will also have to submit a rehabilitation plan for the site.

Gas Co. antenna won't hurt reception - official

A Union Gas spokesman has assured members of the town planning board that a communications tower proposed for Speyside won't interfere with TV or radio reception in the area.

Jim Lovett, supervisor for telecommunications for the company, told the board at a public meeting Tuesday that Union Gas shares a tower with McLean-Hunter Cable TV Ltd. in Hamilton and has towers of its own in 30 other locations throughout the province.

But Esqueping Coun. Pam Sheldon said that, despite the absence of Speyside residents at the meeting, there is considerable concern about the proliferation of towers in the area.

"Surely there must be some way of limiting the number of towers," she said, noting that she had received numerous phone calls regarding the company's proposal to erect a 133-foot tower near the southwest corner of Highway 25 and 17 Sideroad. Halton regional police are currently leasing land on Speyside Public School property for a tower of their own.

Mr. Lovett explained that while the company's frequencies will not interfere with radio or TV reception, they are similar to police broadcasts and cannot share the same tower. Speyside's regionally central and elevated location make it an attractive spot for communications relays.

Residents wishing to comment on the Union Gas proposal have until Feb. 10 to file a letter with the town's planning department before the application comes before town council for approval.
