Lunch hour watch may cost \$100,000

The lunch supervision and facilities committee of the Halton board of education has recommended spending \$100,000 to provide classroom supervision during lunch hour in the region's elementary schools.

The board has been studying problems arising from students eating lunch at school. The minister of education issued a directive confirming the children's right to stay in school during the noon hour.

Elementary school principals have devised various methods of ensuring that children are supervised during lunch hour, but there have been complaints from parents about children eating on the gymnasium floor and lacking supervision.

The committee appointed to study the problem has recommended the hiring of paid supervisors for the lunch hour, and the formation of resource teams to work with the schools and resolve problems related to facilities.

Other boards are paying for lunch hour supervision, the committee pointed out, and paid supervision not only ensures the teachers get the 40-minute lunch period required by law, but enables students to remain at school without parental anxiety about supervision.

The board will vote on the recommendations at its next meeting.

Police seek contract arbitration

The Halton Regional Police Association has filed for arbitration on the contract for the force's civilian employees.

Negotiators from the association and the commission met Friday in an attempt to reach agreement through conciliation. However, the two sides were unable to reconcile their differences and the association filed for arbitration.

This is the second time the association has sought arbitration with this contract. When negotiations on the police and civilian contracts broke down earlier this year, the association filed for arbitration, but the Labor Relations Board appointed a conciliator instead.

With the aid of Victor Scott, the association and the commission were able to reach agreement on the contract for uniformed personnel.
