Tachmen car club expands Motion

Georgetown's Tachmen Car Club is going all out to make Motion '81 the biggest and best all-Canadian rod and custom car show yet.

Motion '81 will feature 300 exhibits of customized cars, hot rods, pick-up trucks, vans, Double-A fuel dragsters and racing boats, and this year the show will be entirely Canadian.

The event opens this weekend at the Toronto International Centre on Airport Road at 6 p.m. Friday. The action gets underway at 7 p.m. with the finals of the first Ms. Toronto Wet T-Shirt Contest. Elimination contests have been held in Toronto bars over the past four weeks, involving over 300 women. In the finals, 24 women representing 12 bars will be competing for a first prize of \$1,000 in cash and a trophy. The judging will be done by the audience with the help of an applause meter.

The world's largest sock hop will kick off at 8 p.m., with music provided by local radio personalities with music from the fifties and early sixties. The dance floor is over 25,000 square feet, with room to dance, and for demonstrations of hula hoops and yo-yos. Prizes will be awarded for the best fifties costumes and for the dancers.

Visitors to the show could even have the opportunity to wind up on television when Global's Gord Martineau hosts the Cash for Life Lottery show at Motion '81 Saturday at 8:30 p.m. The live telecast will include a number of Canadian performers.

Motion '81 opens Friday, running from 6 to 11 p.m. Saturday is an all-day affair from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m., with the show winding up Sunday at 6 p.m. Presentation of the Motion's Awards to the winning exhibitors will be at 4:30 p.m. Sunday.

Computer labs for schools \$99,000

The Halton board of education will vote at its next meeting on setting up three computer laboratories in three secondary schools this year at a cost of \$99,000.

In a report on the board's aim of providing its students with computer literacy, superintendent of program Dr. Robert Dixon recommended establishing three laboratories this year, and setting a time limit of three to five years for equipping each secondary school with a computer laboratory.

One of the aims included in the board policy statement known as Board Aims and Objectives is to provide students with a background in computer studies. Dr. Dixon said in his report that educators are no longer asking whether microcomputers should be used in the classroom, but how they can be used.

Burlington trustee Bill Priestner expressed concern about how quickly the computers would become obsolete and therefore useless as a teaching tool. Dr. Brendan Kelly, coordinator of pure and applied science for the board, said it isn't known how long the computers will last or how long they will be current.
