

Safe to go back in water?

Swimming bylaw bugs ironed out

With some minor changes favorably received by at least three camp and picnic ground owners, the town's general committee has readied a swimming area bylaw for council's anticipated approval next month.

Deleting references to life-guards and regulating highly visible floatlines for swimming spots which already mark off deep or dangerous areas, committee members seemed satisfied that the new bylaw could stand up to a legal challenge. Three weeks ago, the lawyer for Joseph Prucyk, owner of Limestone's Waterfalls Playground, suggested the enactment of swimming regulations is up to the province, and the municipality may be going beyond its jurisdiction forcing the owners of the town's popular, natural swimming areas to comply with its legislation.

Although Mr. Prucyk, Acton's North Park owner Ernie Barber and Smallwood Acres (Acton) owner Charles Smallwood appeared pleased with the removal of the life-guard references, two of them had differing opinions on the role of the police at the swimming spots.

"I don't feel we should waste tax dollars having the police come in on Fridays and Saturdays," Mr. Barber said, commenting on part of the bylaw which entitles Halton police to enforce swimming regulations.

But Mr. Prucyk said he felt the police should be allowed on his property, even though it is

private land, because "when people see them in there, things settle down." While not officially designated as part of the swimming area at Waterfalls Playground, the abandoned quarry nearby is a favorite spot among young adults and teenagers.

Concurring with Coun. Harry Levy, Coun. John

McDonald called the police enforcement of the swimming regulations a "very important element of the bylaw".

Other items within the bylaw call for signs pointing out safety regulations, emergency telephones, lifesaving equipment and hazardous and safe swimming areas. Safety equipment listed in the bylaw

includes an eight-foot reaching pole, a ring buoy and line, a non-inflatable life-preserver and a spinal board for back injuries.

Violators of the new bylaw,

yet to be reviewed by other campground owners offering swimming facilities, could face fines of up to \$1,000. The legislation will return to council April 6 for a final vote.
