Grants assist **CVCA** erosion

control

Approval was received last week from Natural Resources Minister James Auld for a \$364,155 grant to assist the Credit Valley Conservation Authority in carrying out erosion control works on the Credit River and its tributaries during 1981. Total estimated cost of the projects is \$662,100. Completed in 1978, the Hazard Land Study determined an inventory of erosion sites In specific urban centres along seven watercourses within the Credit River watershed. The study also included priorizing of sites and concept design proposals for those sites found to exhibit high potential

hazard. The study examined 106 sites during 1977-78 and, of these, 29 sites were shown to exhibit a high potential hazard to existing residential dwellings, commercial complexes, recreational facilities and public

utilities. Of the erosion sites exhibiting high hazard eight have already been completed, two are nearing completion in early 1981 and twelve more are to be done over the next three

Halton region may still be largely rurally-oriented, but many of its urban residents . and particularly their "neighbors" from adjoining, built-up areas - have little understanding about the operation of a typical farm.

That's the premise behind the recently-created Ontario Vacation Farm Association (OVFA), a group of farm hosts who open their homes to guests interested in spending time on a family-operated farm.
"Many farmers have retain-

ed a good measure of the simple, basic way of living of their forefathers, while at the same time allowing modern technology to make life more pleasant without completely taking over," OVFA director Ria Pulles of Belwood told The Herald recently.

"A farm hollday offers the things that so many people yearn for and it is all here in Ontario! Does it not make sense to develop a thriving tourist industry in our province? There are few places in the city where a person is able to order the kind of home-made meals that one will be served at the farm: fresh, home-made butter, fresh pies and rolls, milk that is still 'the real thing', bread without additives, fruit still warm with sunshine."

Sanctioned and promoted by the Ontario ministry of agriculture and food, OVFA farms are spread across the province (although the closest to Halton Hills is in Orangeville) and are open year-round. Applicants fill out a form in which they specify the dates and length of time of their desired visits; a fee of \$125 per period (a six-day stretch) is charged.

In exchange, they get a working knowledge of a farm life, plenty of hospitality, including room and board, enjoy swimming, canoeing, hiking, sightseeing, crafts and horseback riding. For more information, write
