Renaissance hearing Friday

A tentative date of April 10 (Friday) has been set for a federal court hearing on Revenue Canada's proposal to revoke Renaissance Canada's charitable status.

A spokesman for Bill Rompkey, minister of national revenue, says that Revenue Canada had decided to revoke the organization's charitable status.

Renaissance Canada has filed an appeal with the federal court.

The hearing will be held in Toronto.

In the House of Commons last week, New Democrat Pauline Jewett described Renaissance Canada as a "hate organization" in the guise of a charity.

Ms. Jewett, who represents the B.C. riding of New Westminster-Coquitlam said full-page newspaper advertisements published by Renaissance Canada on the weekend violate rules prohibiting a recognized charity from political activity.

Ms. Jewett, apparently unaware of the pending federal court action, presented the Commons with a motion calling for a review of the organization's status as a charity able to give income tax receipts for donations. Her motion was denied when she failed to get the necessary unanimous consent needed.

Renaissance Canada was founded seven years ago in Milton by Baptist minister Ken Campbell.

The evangelical organization claims a membership of about 10,000.

MP seeks Davis' support on BNA

Progressive Conservative MPs from Ontario have put pressure on Premier Bill Davis to support their stand on the Canadian constitutional issue.

A telegram sent to Davis' office last Thursday asked him to reconsider earlier support of the Trudeau government.

WANT A HALT

The 36 MPs who make up the Ontario PC caucus want debate on the constitution suspended in the House of Commons pending a ruling from the Supreme Court.

The Newfoundland Supreme Court recently stated that the federal government's position to unilaterally send the constitution request to London without feedback from the 10 provinces is illegal.

Brampton-Georgetown MP John McDermid said the country's highest court should decide on the legality of unilateral action.

"We (Ontario MPs) feel very, very strongly that the legality of this has to be straightened out before it gets any further," he said.

Eight of the 10 provinces have already supported the Tory stand. Ontario and New Brunswick have not.

NOT A SHOWDOWN

Mr. McDermid said the Davis telegram is simply a request and does not represent a showdown between Queen's Park and the federal MPs.

"It's a request of Davis," he said.
