

Renew lottery for second year?

# Continue Actario? Let organizers know

The question of continuing the Actario draw for more than one year will depend on the wishes of Acton residents and organizations, says committee chairman Ted Tyler.

Mr. Tyler said last week his committee sees the draw as a good thing and they'd like to continue with it but he wants feedback from the community to confirm that opinion.

If it is to continue beyond Sept. 1, preparations need to be started by June to prepare for a second year, he said.

That means Mr. Tyler would like to know whether subscribers would be willing to purchase tickets a second year and merchants would be willing to sponsor a prize a second year.

He feels the draw has created a meeting place every Saturday morning on Mill Street and residents seem to enjoy it as much as merchants like the customers drawn down to see the draw.

The committee would like to hear from those who have been involved by the end of April so they can begin planning for a second year if that's what is wanted. This time they'd like to form a new committee to include some of the organizations who were so helpful in selling tickets.

The work load isn't all that heavy and present commit-

tee members have their various roles down pat now. It's the time commitment and always having to be there on Saturday morning that makes Mr. Tyler and others feel they've done their share.

Next year's draw could be set up on the same sort of basis, but with service clubs taking about a month to handle the actual draw. That would allow everyone to share in the work load but make the time span shorter.

The question of whether more or less tickets should be sold a second year is also open to discussion.

"Last year we were pressed for time," he says. "We had to get started if we were going to get off the ground. So we grabbed some arbitrary figures like 1,000 tickets at \$100 each. Maybe it was too high a price. Maybe there weren't enough. Who knows?"

"This time we'd like to hear from the people themselves what they'd like to see us do. We think we've got a good thing going and we'd like to carry on but we aren't going to shove something down people's throats if they don't want it."

For while the ticket sales were dead, he admits. Then when the price dropped to \$50 they put up a couple of signs around reminding people of the rate decrease and they sold about 10 tickets in one weekend.

Now they hear there are

more people waiting for the time when the price has dropped to \$25 because that's the price range they can afford.

The draws may not be earning the amount the committee had originally hoped through interest over the year but draw expenses have been covered and every sale is profit.

An article on the North Halton Association For the Mentally Retarded's (NHAMR) "Be A Friend" program which appeared in last Wednesday's issue of The Herald, incorrectly stated that the provincial ministry of community and social services and the NHAMR would share the expenses of a volunteer course slated to begin at Sheridan College next month. In fact, the college is sponsoring the course aimed at training volunteers to help mentally handicapped adults cope with living away from homes for the retarded and similar institutes. Eighty per cent of the costs of the other services which the NHAMR offers - vocational and residential training for the mentally handicapped - are picked up by the ministry, while the Association raises the remaining 20 per cent from the public. Meanwhile, people interested in the "Be A Friend" program course which will span over several weeks, are invited to attend a special information night April 8 in the NHAMR's Georgetown office at 9 Wesleyan Street.
