

# Sharing expenses

## SHARING EXPENSES THE GROOM

- || The bride's engagement and wedding rings.
- || The marriage license.
- || Gifts for his attendants.
- || Wedding present for the bride.

- || Boutonnieres for the men in the wedding party.
- || Bride's bouquet and going-away corsage.

## THE GROOM'S FAMILY

- || Any travelling expenses.
- || Wedding present for the bride and groom.
- || Their own clothes for the wedding.
- || Optional: rehearsal dinner.

## THE BRIDE

If the bride has money of her own, she may elect to pay for the following expenses. If not, her family is usually responsible for these costs.

- || Personal stationery and calling cards.
- || Accommodations for her attendants.

- || Gifts for her attendants.
- || Wedding present for the bridegroom.
- || Wedding band for the groom, if it is a double ring ceremony.

## THE BRIDES FAMILY

- || Engagement and wedding pictures.
- || Wedding invitations and enclosure cards.
- || Announcements and mailing expenses.

- || Bride's personal trousseau (wedding gown and accessories, going-away outfit).
- || Entire cost of the reception (decorations, music, flowers, food, including wedding cake and beverage).

- || Rental of the hall.
- || Fee for the organist.
- || Floral decorations.
- || Bridesmaid's flowers.
- || Aisle carpet, canopy and other church property.
- || Bridesmaids' luncheon, if any.

- || Rehearsal dinner (the groom's parents may elect to pay for this).
- || Transportation for bridal party to the ceremony and reception.

- || Optional: linens, china and other household necessities for the newlyweds.

## SPEECHES AND TOASTS

1. To the Bride: By the clergyman or friend of the Bride's family, not a relative
2. Response: By the Groom
3. To the Bridesmaids: By the Groom
4. Response: By the Best Man or Head Usher.
5. To the Parents of the Bride: By the Best Man or Master of Ceremonies
6. Response: By the Father of the Bride.
7. To the Parents of the Groom: By the Best Man or Master of Ceremonies
8. Response: By the Father of the Groom

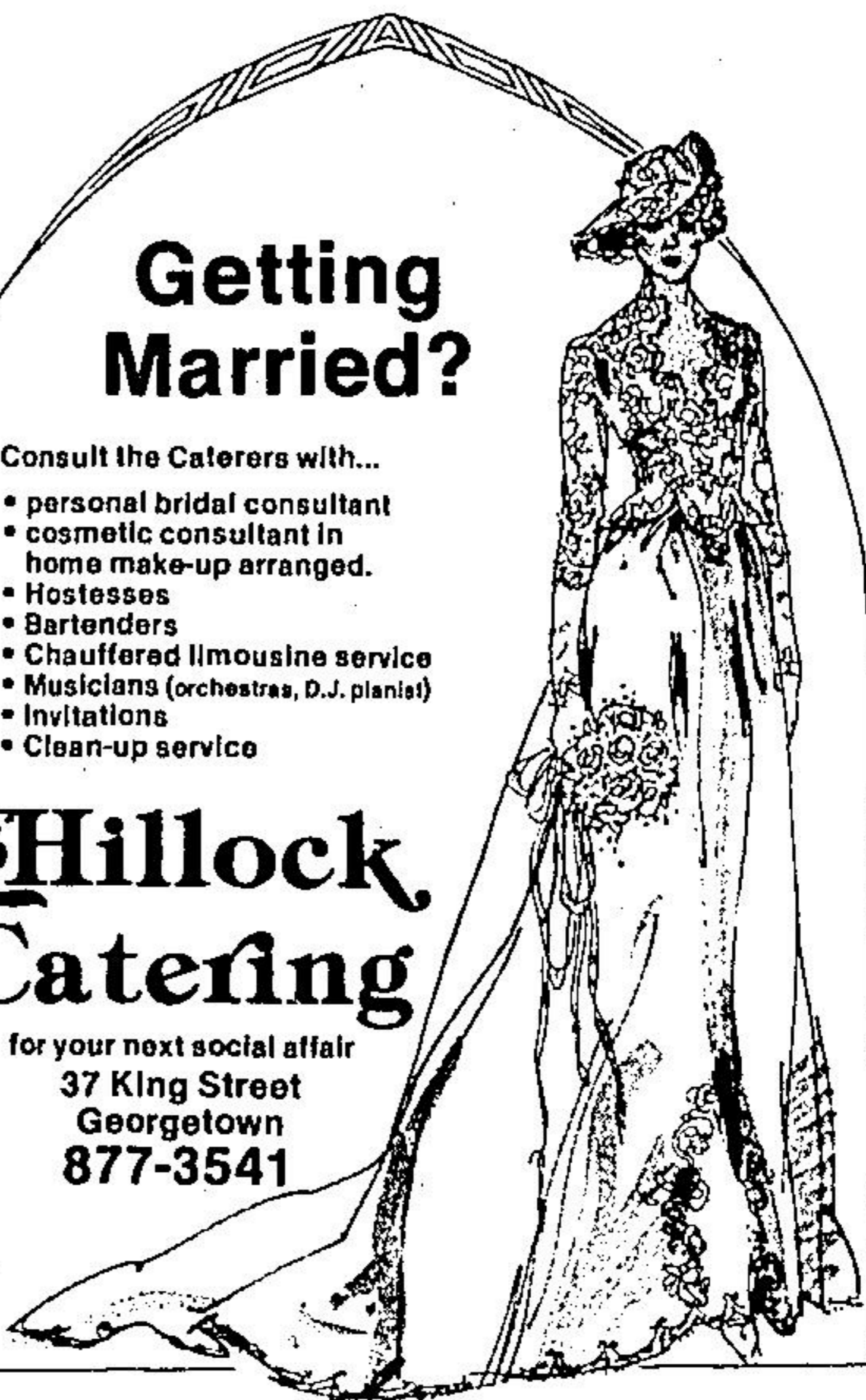

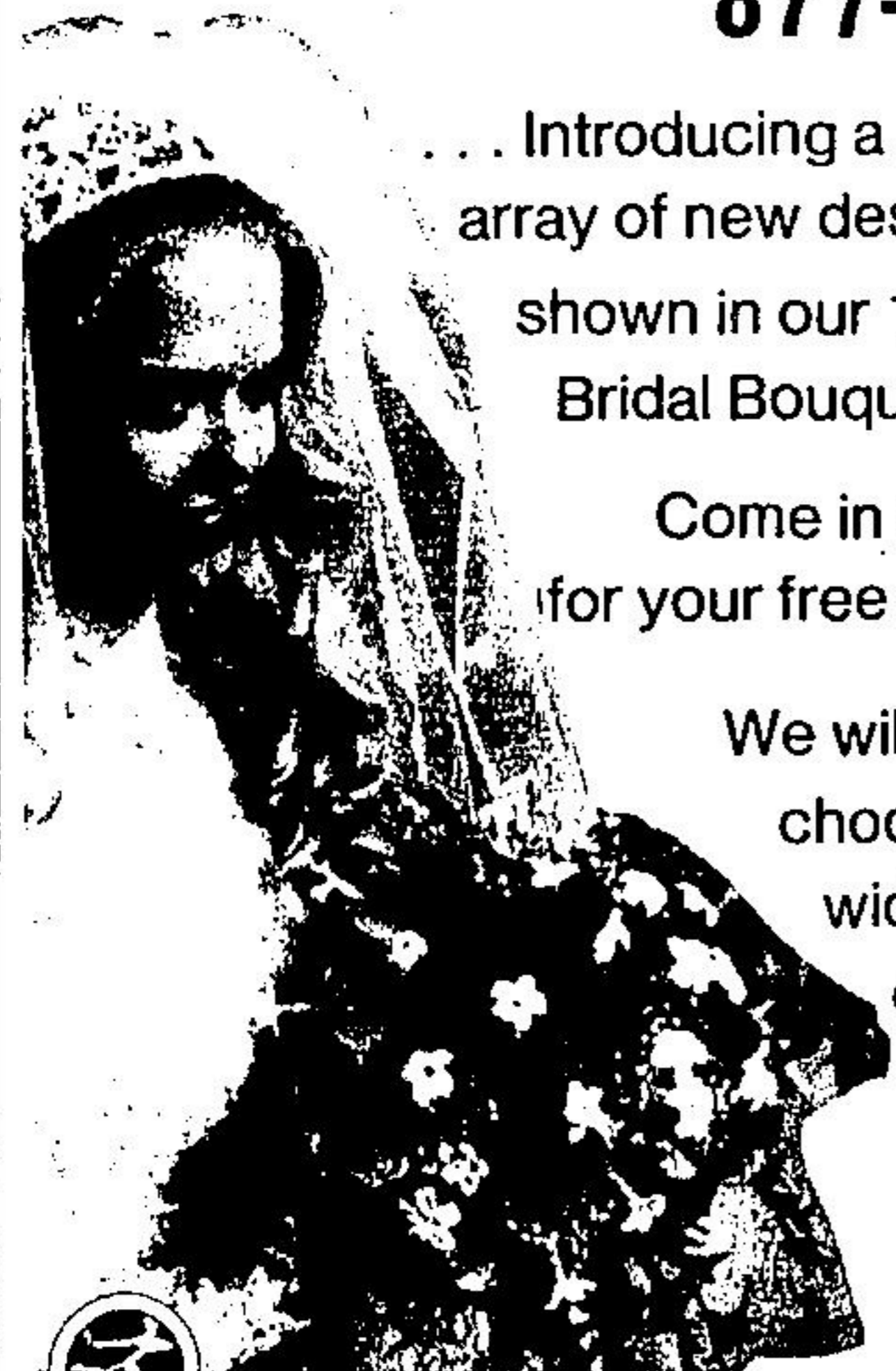
