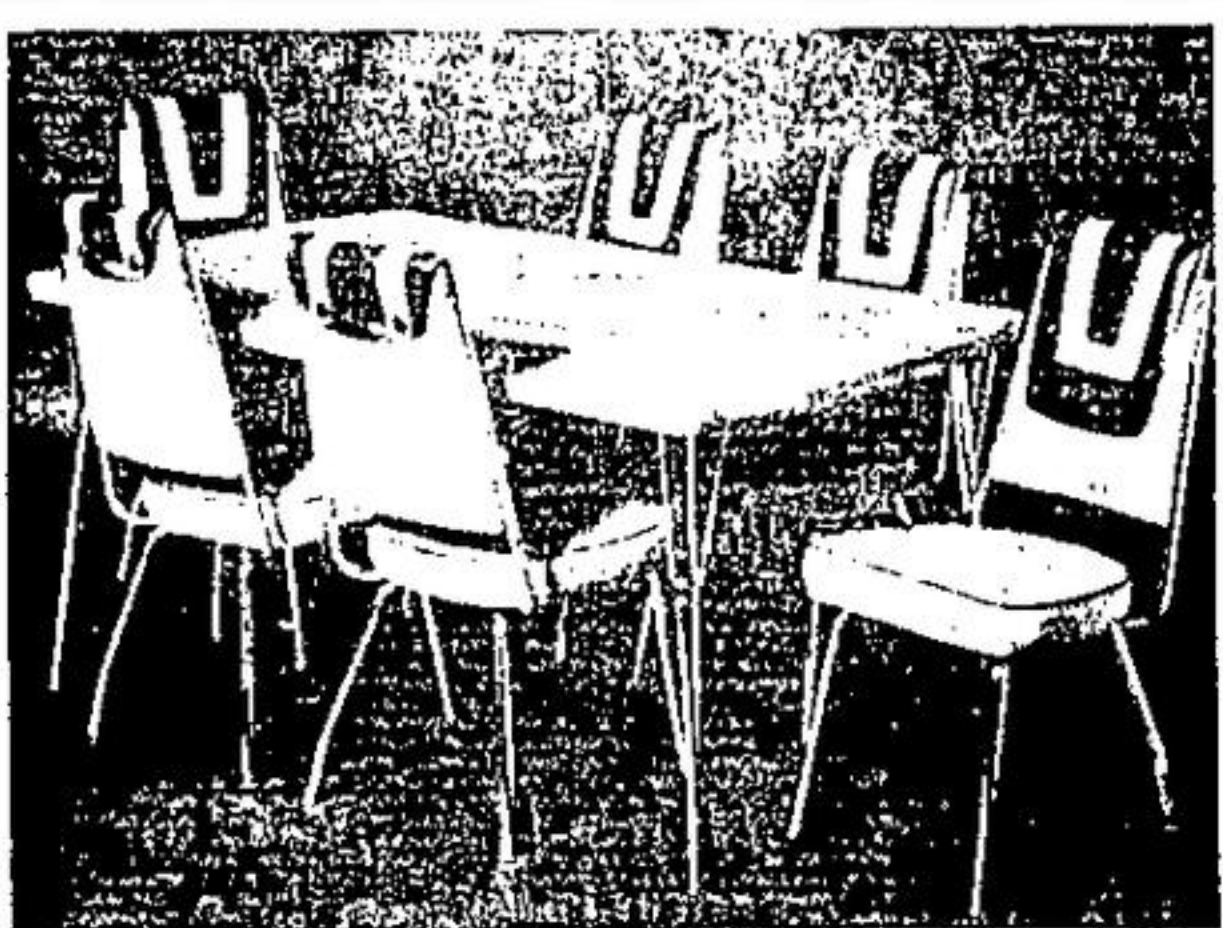

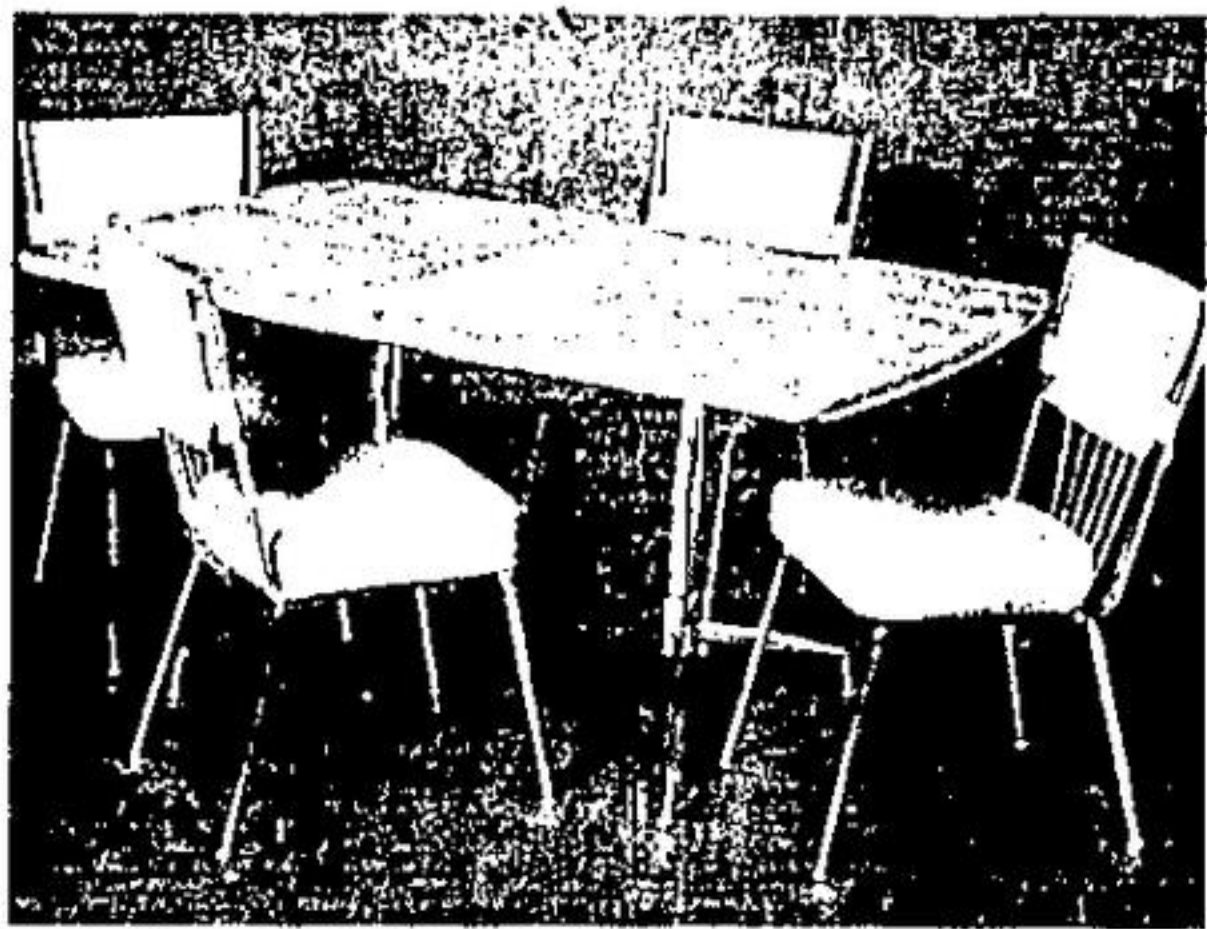

Getting to know duplicate

Duplicate Bridge is a fascinating game. Any pair at the table at any given time can win if that pair does the right thing at the right time.

For example, a hand may be situated such that the North-South pair have two spades their way for a score of +110. However, if the East-West pair bid three diamonds

over the two spades and go down on vulnerable but not doubled, they lose only 100 points and thus win over all other East-West pairs allowing their opposition to bid and make two spades.

All very confusing. Perhaps the hand will demonstrate further.

THE ANALYSIS:

If East opens 2 H, South will double for takeout, but West, at this vulnerability, should just bid 4 H. At tables where East does not start with 2 H, South will open 1 D and West may overcall 2 C.

East should then make up for his previous pass by leaping to 3 H which West will raise to game.

The defense against 4 H should begin with a diamond lead and continuation. Those

Souths who shift to a trump at trick two to prevent declarer from ruffing a diamond in dummy may be rewarded with -620 for a top. However, our hearts go out to the unfortunate South who,

having found the trump shift, then watches a daring East take both the club finesse and the spade finesse, enabling him to get rid of all three of his remaining diamonds for -680 and a bottom.
