## 'Need alternative system' Post office monopoly feared by MP McDermid

 The Crown corporation which takes over operation of the postal system should not be granted a monopoly, Brampton-Georgetown MP John McDermid has told the House of Commons. All Canadians are hopeful that many of the problems and difficulties associated with the post office will disappear with the creation of a Crown corporation. Mr. McDermid said, but if they do not the people should have an option. "People should have the freedom of choice about how they want their catalogues delivered and how they want their bills delivered," he argued. In the Peel region, gas and electric utilities hand deliver their bills to customers, and "the people want to be assured that this can be done if the post office falls them." He said during debate on the bill to establish the corpora-

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
