

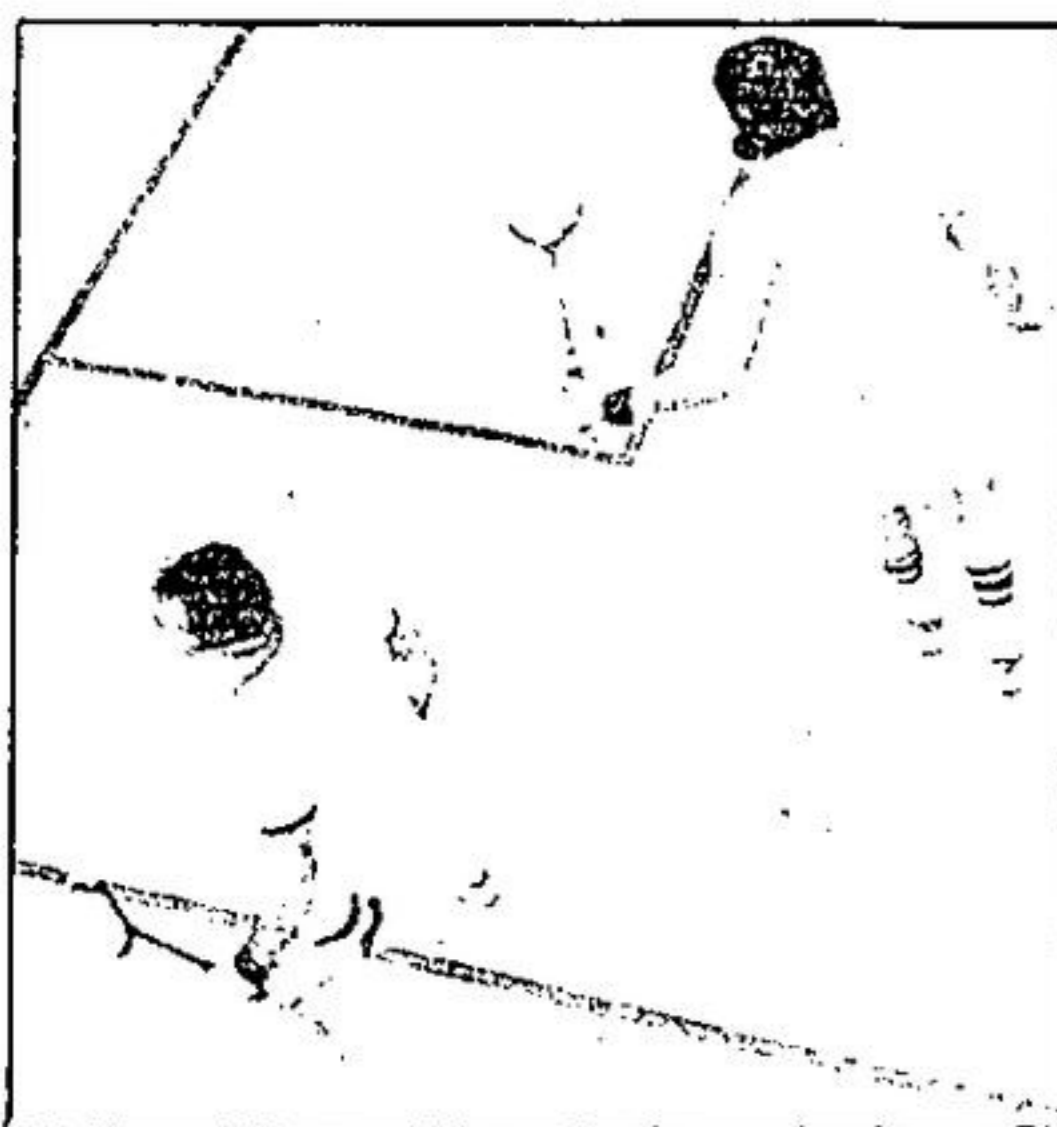

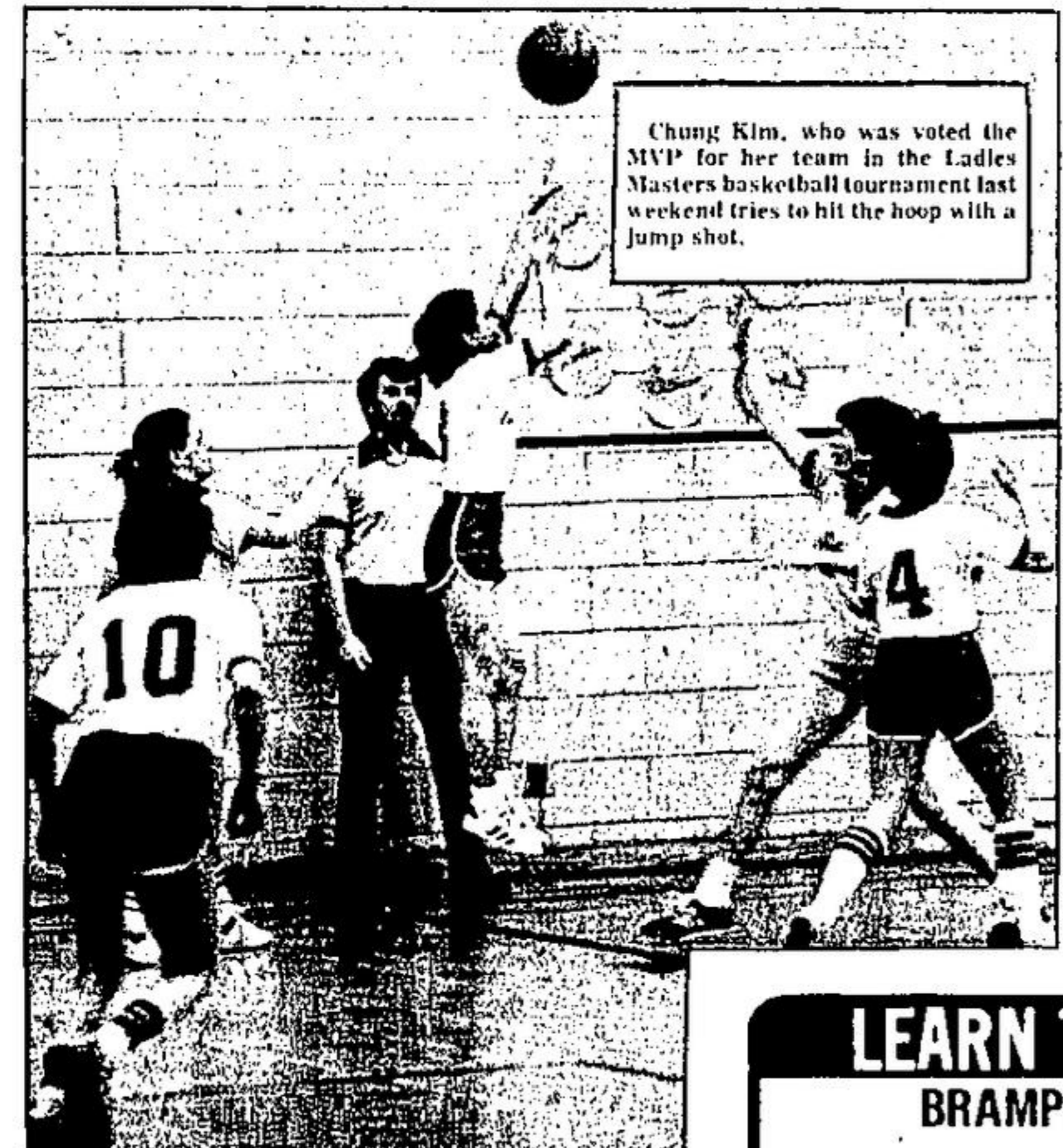
Coach Jules Russiani to pick European-bound Midgets

Two representatives of the Guelph Minor Hockey Association were at the Acton Sabres awards banquet last Friday night and they approached coach Jules Russiani with an interesting proposal.

The Guelph Minor Hockey people want Russiani to pick their Midget team this coming year in preparation for their tour of Czechoslovakia in November. The tour will be two weeks in length and although Russiani was asked to come along, he has declined.

However, Russiani has accepted the task of picking out a midget squad which should consist of 20 players from a selection of 60 to 80 hockey players. The Acton coach says he will be looking for speed, in both the players' physical and mental approach to the game.

The midgets already have a coach and manager and Russiani says his involvement with the midgets will be limited to the time spent on choosing players for their team. Russiani has said he will return with the Acton Junior B Sabres as coach and will be heavily involved with the Sabres early in the season trying to improve on their lacklustre start of last year.
