## Penrice succeeds Crawford as Chamber president

The board of directors of the Georgetown Chamber of Commerce has reorganized its ranks slightly in its nominations for 1981.

Club, Chamber president Bill Crawford, who was unable to attend, was succeeded by former first vice-president Doug Penrice. Brenda Sinnett moved up from second to first vice-president. There were no nominations for a new second vice-president.

Eight of the directors who served last year remain on the board but have lost four of their former co-workers. Remaining directors are

Lynn Barnard, Al Fraser, Murray Lawton, Brian MacAdam, Bill Ward, Rick West, Rud Whiting and Dick Willis. Mayor Pete Fomeroy remains the Chamber's honorary director. There are still two vacancies on the board of directors since a maximum of 12 directors is permitted.

## Still objects to IGA

Optimism that a proposal for an expanded IGA plaza in Acton would proceed without a hitch dwindled Monday night as another developer said he would only drop his objection to the plan if the town is prepared to let him build a shopping centre on the community's eastern boundary. In a letter to Coun. Mike Armstrong, the town's planning board chairman, Landawn Shopping Centres president Jerry Sprackman said he is ready to drop a zoning objection to the IGA proposal slated for the site of the old Dominion Hotel once the town redrafts Acton's urban boundaries, including the Landawn proposal within the community's limits. While the Landawn proposal and the town's objections are already headed for an Ontario Municipal Board hearing, The Freed-Kassian Investments Limited IGA idea may eventually wind up there as well.

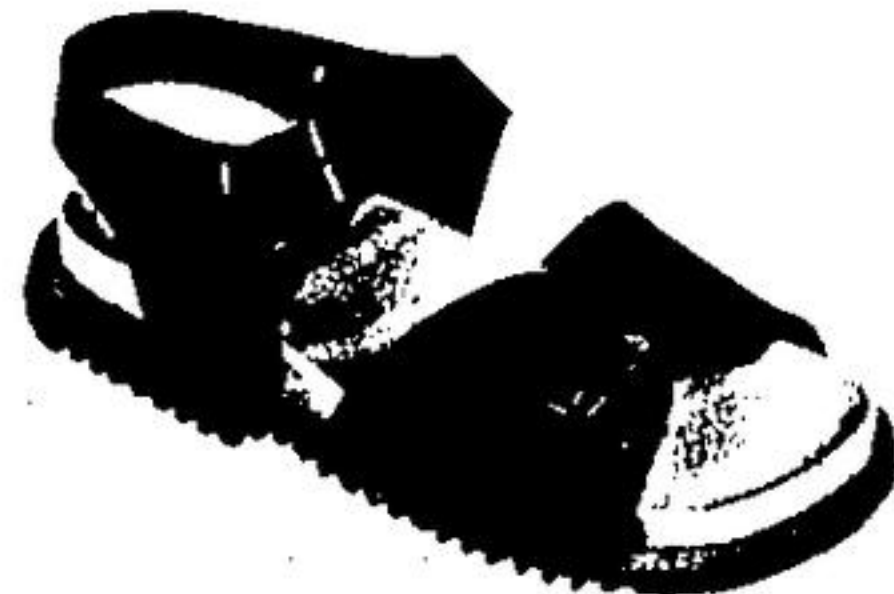
