Houses now out of reach - **MP** 

A Canadian family which one year ago could carry a \$50,000 first mortgage on an income of \$28,207 now needs an income of \$32,213 to do so, according to Brampton-Georgetown MP John McDermid.

Rising mortgage interest rates have pushed home ownership out of the reach of most young couples, the Con-servative MP told the House of Commons Tuesday, since the average family income in Canada is now \$28,000 a year. The Commons nevertheless failed to unanimously endorse Mr. McDermid's bill for debate as is necessary,

thus rejecting his motion to have Prime Minister Pierre

Trudeau fire finance minister Allan McEachern and the minister responsible for housing, Paul Cosgrove. The two, Mr. McDermid said, should be replaced with ministers who are genuinely

concerned about the plight of citizens who must renew their mortgages and those who find they cannot afford their own house. MP John

predicts long nights

Herald Special Canada's economic constitution will be as important as the country's legal one during debates in Parliament's spring session which this week kicks off a series of discussions described by Brampton-Georgetown MP McDermid as critical to the

future of Canada. Mr. McDermid said last week he expects late nights and heated debates over economic hassles and constitution discussions.

Mr. McDermid arrived in Ottawa Tuesday to begin what could be one of the longest. heaviest sessions in the last few years.

NOSURPRISES The Brampton-Georgetown MP and his Progressive Conservative Party met Wednesday in caucus to discuss strate-

gy but its tactics won't come as much of a surprise. Mr. McDermid said the PCs already have met a number of times in the past month to prepare for the issues that lie

That will include: a Young Offenders Bill which would make young criminals responsible for their actions, legislation to shorten the fede-ral election by 12 days, and a Freedom of Information bill which will go to the House of Commons for final approval. But the major source of

debate in the Commons over the next three months should focus on the economic situation which has seen interest rates skyrocket, unemployment soar, and western provinces - especially Alberta -squirm under the final appro-val of the controversial oil and Canada's constitution pack-

age will also return to the forefront during the session back after Supreme Court consideration. Parliament will give it a two-day review before sending it to England, if the court rules it legal. Mr. McDermid said tnat

interest rate increases will be one of the Conservative Party's prime concerns.
