

Slide show, plant sale tonight

The May meeting of Georgetown Horticultural Society will be held Wednesday (May 20) at 8 p.m. in Knox Presbyterian Church Hall. At this meeting, the prize winning slides of the Ontario Horticultural Association's 1980 Photographic Competition will be shown.

Following a short business meeting, the annual plant sale takes place. Everyone is welcome to come and buy at the sale tables. If you have any plants to donate to the sale, they will be very acceptable. Come and see the Mini Flower Show, too.

Members of Georgetown Horticultural Society will be showing their "I Love Georgetown" spirit by assisting the downtown merchants to plant annuals on the Main Street planters.

On June 20, in conjunction with Pioneer Days, the Annual Flower Show and Strawberry Social returns. These activities are at Knox Church Hall. Start to think Flower Show now, so you will be ready to enter an arrangement then.

In April, Collin Dickinson of Maple Leaf Research Centre spoke about lawns. Mr. Dickinson is a specialist in agricultural crops with emphasis on grasses. The maintenance program that most people can use for creating and keeping a

good lawn requires good seed, proper fertilizers and correct watering. Lawns enhance your buildings and add to the value of your property.

A good raking with a spring rake is the first activity for spring lawn care. Check, as you go along, for snow mould, mice damage, chinch bug damage, dead thatch and late frost damage. Bare patches left by these troubles can be re-seeded or over seeded.

Dead thatch is caused by poor drainage or poor soil. Get rid of the thatch by raking or using a dethatcher machine, then, seed or over seed.

A Kentucky Blue Grass, Creeping Red Fescue and annual Rye Grass blend is a good one. Be sure to ask for advice from a competent supplier when you have a special area to care for. Kentucky blue grass is aggressive, winter hardy and disease resistant. It grows in full sun and repairs quickly. Get a named variety mixture. Creeping red fescue grows in shaded areas. Do not over fertilize in shaded areas, about half as much fertilizer as in full sun.

Perennial rye grass germinates rapidly and is good as a nurse crop for other grasses. It is not as winter hardy as other grasses. Fast grass which is offered for sale now is mostly perennial rye grass. It is not as good a looking turf as

some and tends to shred when being cut. This gives a brown tinge to the lawn. It can be over seeded with Kentucky blue grass.

To plant small areas, put grass seed in a jar with a metal lid in which you have made small holes. Then use to seed the grass as you would use a salt shaker. In large areas, measure the ground so you can keep track of the area covered and plant 4 to 5 pounds per 1000 square feet. Prepare area to be seeded, fertilize, sow and firm ground.

When grass is ready to cut, 3 to 4 inches, adjust the mower, so half the length of the grass leaf will be left. Do not use herbicides on tender seedlings. Be sure the mower blades are sharp. Scaping when you mow, will cause weed problems. Fill in the dips so scaping will not occur.

Fertilize lawns early with a 10-6-4 formula at 10 pounds per 1000 square feet. Do the same in June or July. In September, the rate is 5 pounds per 1000 square feet with a 5-20-20 formula. Fresh seeding needs heavy feed, 20 to 30 lbs. per 1000 square feet. Grass needs a quick start or the weeds germinate and take over.

Drought problems show up under trees first. Water so there is one inch of soaked soil for every ten days. A pulsating sprinkler used in early morning is the best watering method.

In late July or early August, if you suspect that the lawn is

being attacked by chinch bugs, which feed on plant stems, cut the top and bottom from a fruit juice can, hammer the can into the soil and fill it with water. Grubs will come to the surface of the water if there are chinch bugs. Spray with diazinon. Chlordane helps to control white grub. Crab grass control - use dacthal when forsythia is in bloom or use in granular form in the fall. Plantain and dandelion control use 2-4-D. Quack grass control - mow often or use "round-up". Orchard grass control - dig it out. Round leaf mallow and prostrate knot weed - use Killer. Use a herbicide spray early in the morning when there will be no rain for 6 or 7 hours after application. Use sprays as directed. Spray drift can be dangerous. 2-4-D is harmful to evergreens.

MAY IDEAS
Plant seeds when the oak leaves are the size of a mouse's

ear. Warm soil speeds germination and promotes strong rooting of seedlings. Harden off indoor started seedlings and wait until the frosts are over before setting out. When your Easter Lily leaves begin to turn yellow, cut the stem back to 4 or 5 inches. Take the bulb out of the pot and plant the bulb 6 inches deep in good soil in your garden. These bulbs are winter hardy and will flower in your garden.
