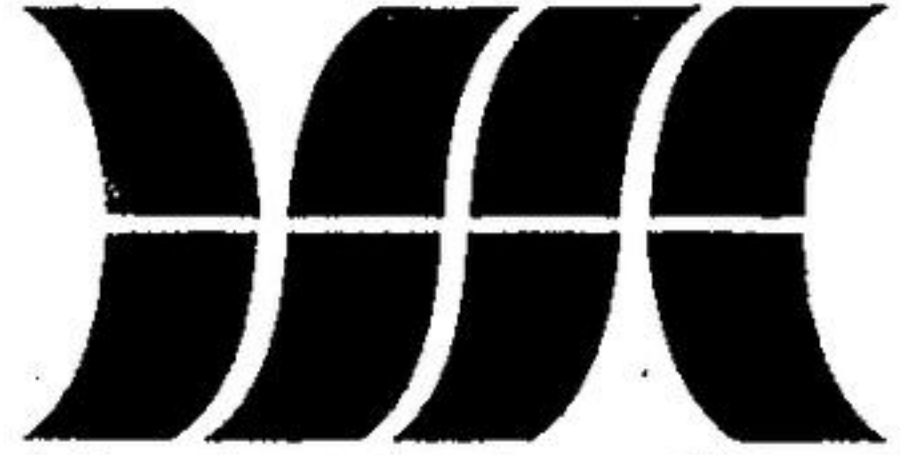


# HALTON HILLS ARTS COUNCIL

# Newest fund-raiser

Continued from page A5 receive wider recognition locally.

Jean Ruddell, president of the Rug Hookers, said members were pleased to be able to use their craft to assist the Arts Council in its fund-raising efforts.

On behalf of the different arts organizations in town the Arts Council and Georgetown Little Theatre made separate pledges totalling \$50,000 - a quarter of the \$200,000 public subscription campaign announced by Mayor Pete Pomeroy in March, 1980.

Through a variety of activities - such as the Council's historical mural, the Georgetown Choral Society's "Cultural Awareness in North Halton" campaign, the University Women's Club's Historical House Tour as well as the GLT plaques - fund-raising by arts-related organizations is now estimated at close to \$40,000.

The staff of Georgetown library, which is also a member-organization of the Arts Council, have thus far raised more than \$3,000 independently and, like the Arts Council, are planning other activities.

Information and pledge forms for the Rug Hangings Drive will be available at the Old Tyme Musical Hall dinner-cabaret show at Sacre Coeur Hall, starting at 7 p.m. this Saturday.

Name-spaces on the two rug hangings are being offered at the same rate as the seat-plaques - \$10 monthly for 12 months (minimum donation \$120) or \$110 in a minimum single lump sum.

Since donations to official municipal projects are tax exempt, all rug name-space purchases are recognized as charitable donations for income tax purposes. All donors will be issued an official receipt by the Town of Halton Hills prior to income tax filing.

The former chairman of the GLT drive is heading up the new campaign on behalf of the Arts Council and the Rug Hookers. Donations to the HHAC Rug Hangings Drive should be sent to C-O John Roe, 63 Faludon Drive, Georgetown, Ontario, L7G 1H9.

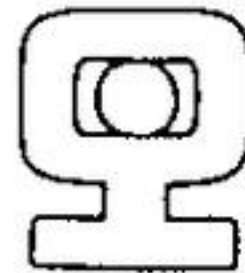
