Backyard barbecuing is as much a rite of summer as baseball, mosquitoes and sun-burns. In the past few years

more and more people have been sizzling their steaks and cooking their "burgers" over a propane flame and the charcoal bar-b-q is as popular as

ever. Both types of bar-b-q's however can present a potential hazard to the careless user, points out the Halton Hills Fire Department.

One home owner found out the hard way, that it is best to let used charcoal cool off for at least 24 hours after dumping the ashes in an outside garbage area next to the house, the fire department put out a \$15,000 fire which severely damaged the building.

The fire department offers the following points of interest to all area chefs:

— use bar-b-q's outdoors - NEVER inside

— use extreme care when applying starter fluid to charcoal and don't reapply the fluid to a lit bar-b-q

— be careful when using electric starters. They can remain hot even when unplugged

— don't leave a propane cylinder in your car trunk. If you must carry the cylinder there, prop open the trunk lid

to prevent heat build-up that could open the cylinder's relief valve. This would allow explosive propane to escape

— don't store propane cylinders in your house

— make sure all connections are tight, especially at the propane cylinder

— make sure the regulator is in good condition and the vent opening is pointing downwards to prevent moisture from entering.

When purchasing a propane barbecue, it is suggested that the one you choose have a label from the Canadian Gas Association (CGA), Canadian Standards Assoc. (CSA) or Underwriters Laboratories of Canada (ULC) to ensure the product has been tested and found acceptable in Canada.

Enjoy your barbecue with care.

THE ANALYSIS:

All roads seem to lead to a final contract of 4 S for NS with the adverse vulnerability deterring E-W from taking a 5 H sacrifice that goes for 500. A possible sequence: E - Pass, S - 10, W - 1 H, N - 1 S, E - 2 H, S - 2 S, W - 3 H, N - 4 S, all pass. North could also put a quick end to the proceedings by leaping to 4 S at his first turn. E-W can beat 4 S but it is not easy. West should play a low heart (any high heart would

ask for continuation of the suit) on East's opening lead of the H-K. East should then conclude that his partner wants a diamond shift. East can see 10 diamonds between his hand and dummy's, making the possibility of a void or stiff ace in West's hand very likely. If East finds the diamond play, West wins and returns the H-Q to East's A to request the diamond return and a bundle of points if there's
