## Getting to know duplicate

North's hand is good enough, with the five card club suit, to open 2NT. However, his spade stopper is weak. Many players will choose the call that must completely describe their values and hope that partner has enough spades to provide a stopper.

It is unlikely that East will venture into the auction over 2 N T, so the bidding will probably die (although an overly optimistic South might raise). North will soon learn that he needs to make five

discards. If he can manage to go down only two he may well salvage some matchpoints on this trouble hand.

He may induce unwary East into the trap of leading a heart at trick eight. This enables declarer to win the heart in dummy and take a club finesse for down two.

## Calendars stay same separate schools say

The Halton Roman Catholic Separate School Board has decided to forego additional expense and remain with its old design format in school calendars.

Trustee Irene McCauley told The Herald that the board decided last Tuesday to keep the old format since it would be far too expensive to print larger calendars. Some 10,000 calendars will be printed this year at a cost of \$5,600.

It had been questioned earlier whether or not the board could print calendars with larger squares for days of the month in order that it would be more convenient for users to write notes. The board decided to print an extra 1,000 calendars, though, since it ran out of calendars last year. The calendars were distributed last year to all the children attending separate schools, parish priests and anyone else requesting one.

## Experience '81 is 'go'

This summer will mark the ninth consecutive year of the Ontario Experience Program. This program is sponsored by the Ontario government to help offset high student unemployment during the summer months. The program provides career related experience for high school, college and university students.

This year the Halton Region Conservation Authority was granted \$45,000 to employ 35 students for periods ranging from seven to 12 weeks. Some of the students' jobs will consist of park maintenance, stream cleanup, erosion control, landscaping and construction. Other students will be involved with an educational program at the Mountsberg Wildlife Center.

The students for technical positions dealing with Bird Banding and Resource Analysis, as well as administration staff and a graphic artist. As in past years, the Halton Region Conservation Authority and the Youth Secretariat are expecting another successful and productive summer under the Ontario Experience Program.

## BASEMENT BUNGALOW WITH OUTSTANDING REAR VIEW

Here's a smartly styled and practical three bedroom bungalow home design which is perfectly suited to the medium frontage residential building lot, especially one which slopes downward to the rear of the site. The plan provides for 1,200 square feet of well-organized finished floor area, for present use, and more space is available for future development in the full basement. The low-profile exterior is finished in mixed vertical and horizontal channel siding and brick veneer, with small-paned windows and a heavy shake roof. For those who prefer, the roof could be alternately finished in shingles, according to regional material costs.

The deeply weather-protected main entry leads traffic through the wide front-facing patio, into a long reception foyer and outer-wear storage area, and directly forward into the large rear-facing living room. The living room features a raised-hearth masonry fireplace and a sliding glass walk-through leading onto the wide rear balcony. Double pocket doors connect the living room to the separate dining room, providing for greater privacy when entertaining. The dining room also features sliding glass doors which provide access to the rear balcony.

A well-planned L-configuration kitchen provides a step-saving work triangle, generous countertop work surfaces and abundant cupboard storage facilities. For those who prefer, the work counter presently separating the kitchen and dining room could be constructed as a convenient snack-bar counter. The mud room facility is sunken two stairs from the kitchen level. From this area, a stairway leads down to the full basement, and access is gained to the single carport. The carport could easily be constructed as a double unit, depending upon lot width and individual requirements.

All three bedrooms are positioned around the central bathroom and linen storage area. Each has excellent exposure for view and natural light, and each has generous closet storage facilities. The large master bedroom has double closets flanking the fireplace wall, and a three-piece ensuite bathroom with shower. The front-facing secondary bedroom could have French doors or a sliding glass walk-through installed; in conjunction with further development of the front patio, such as the installation of an enclosed greenhouse or solarium.

The full basement provides abundant space for the gradual development of additional accommodations or recreational facilities.

Plans for design No. 80-1183 may be purchased either by the single set, at a cost of \$110.00 for the first set and \$20.00 for each additional set, or by the package.
