Audience gets chance to open up

Herald Staff Writer The North Halton Hospice Care Interest Group held their fourth and final forum last Wednesday night in what was an informative and revealing look at how people feet about death.

The group has been organized by three Halton women. Karen Ferguson, Marguarite Knechtel and Eva Sansom, to discuss death, dying and bereavement and to help people cope with death themselves or in their family.

the meeting were asked to participate freely in the discussions, offering their opinions and raising questions. They also did various exercises designed to get them thinking about the different aspects of death and how they would deal with their own terminal

When participants were asked why they fear death, the similar. They all fear the loneliness, pain, lack of control and what their terminal illness could do to their familles. The 20 people who attended Religion or faith was mention-

ed often as being the cornerstone to coping with a terminal iliness along with the necessary support of family and

The group also was asked to imagine that they each only had 48 hours to live and to say what they felt their first actions or reactions would be. Shock, disbelief and the need to set things in order registerresponses were surprisingly fed high on the lists of most participants.

Eva Sansom also discussed courage and outlined some basic steps on how people can lies the will to live. Above all, provide encouragement for one should try to retain and use

someone who is terminally ill. She said that they should give attention by just being there and listening to the

person when they want to talk. They should ask for feedback from the person on how they feel about their situation and encourage them to talk about it. They should always try to find something good to say and emphasize contributions the person is still making. Glving hope and restoring faith are also important since therein

their sense of humor. Since this was the group's last seminar for the summer, the co-ordinators announced the series of classes they have

organized for the fall.

The course is called Developing Resources for Supporting the Dying and Bereaved.

During the seven-week course, group members hope they can acquire some knowledge of the physical and emotional aspects of death and investigate their personal feelings about death - their own or someone else's. They




