The government has forced an end to committee debate on the Astra-Re-Mor financial scandal, and may well have destroyed the spirit of co-operation necessary to discuss other issues. However, the government contends that it is not trying to cover up events which led to the licensing and subsequent collapse of several investment firms. Nevertheless, Liberal Leader Stuart Smith maintains that the Conservatives are using their majority position to block any attempt by the justice committee, the courts or a judicial inquiry to examine Ministry and Ontario Securities Commission records in the matter.

its budget because most farmers in financial trouble don't know about it or qualify for it. Although the Minister of Agriculture often uses the program as an example of how the province helps out farmers facing bankruptcy, only three farmers have had their loans guaranteed in the past two months under the Ontario Young Farmers Credit Program.

Meanwhile, Liberal House Leader Bob Nixon maintains that Ontario farmers are so burdened by financial problems that they cannot "have a civil word with their wives or plant a straight row of corn". Farmers cannot compete with Quebec farmers who get a total of almost twice

as much money from their government, he said. Quebec offers "three times the number of dollars per farm as we have in the province of Ontario" in assistance programs "and still our cattle producers are competing on the same Toronto market with truckloads of cattle that come up from that province".

OTHER MATTERS
Legislation overhauling the Ontario Human Rights Code has been given second reading, and is now before committee for clause-by-clause study. Angry Opposition MPPs forced a temporary adjournment of the Legislature when only five Conservatives out of 70 bothered to attend for the NDP Leader's response to the provincial budget.

New drivers will be on two years' probation before getting permanent licences. If they accumulate six demerit points in a one year period, they will lose their licences for thirty days.

Under new legislation, Ontario workers laid off in plant shutdowns will receive a week's severance pay for every year of service. Employees with five years service will apparently be eligible for severance pay up to a half year's salary. The legislation will apply only to companies with fifty or more employees. Premier Davis has refused to levy an excess profits tax on banks in Ontario, using the money thus spared to cushion soaring mortgage interest rates.

ONTARIO HYDRO

Approval to begin construction of the Darlington nuclear generating station has been granted by the Atomic Energy Control Board, and work on the \$6.64 billion plant is expected to begin immediately. Recently, Liberal Leader Stuart Smith introduced a resolution condemning money being spent on the plant which could instead be put into development of alternative fuels and conservation.

Ontario Hydro has been given the go-ahead by the Minister of Energy for its long-delayed plans for a high-power transmission line to carry electricity from the Bruce nuclear generating complex across the farmland of Southwestern Ontario. Last December, the Minister called a halt to the planning process, and the NDP Chairman of the select committee on Ontario Hydro has charged that this was done because the government "didn't want this very controversial problem on the eve of an election".

Liberal Leader Stuart Smith has charged that two government ministers contradicted the opinions of their own staff on the farming potential of land which developers wanted rezoned for residential use.
