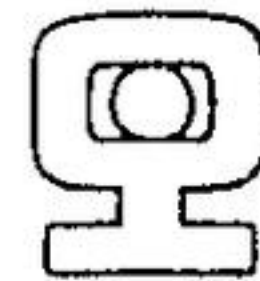

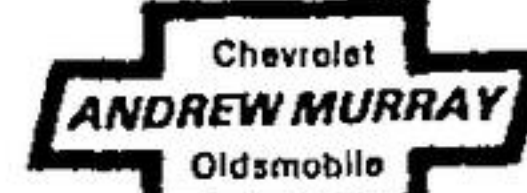
### Halton board's head of education
