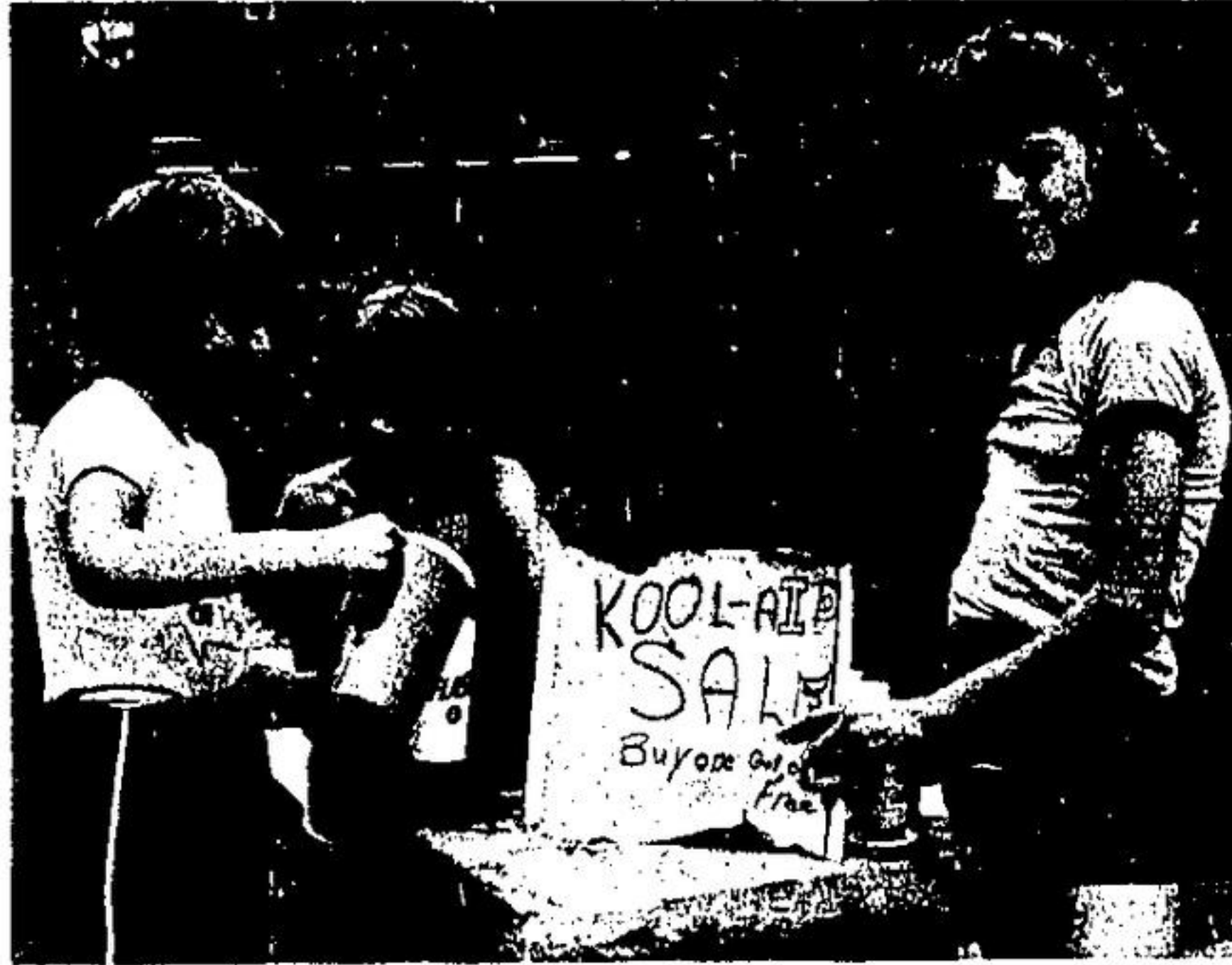


# Welfare cheques must go through - region

Due to the current postal strike, Halton region has made alternative arrangements for distributing welfare cheques. In Acton, daily cheques will be hand delivered by workers from the community service centre in the YMCA offices at the rear of the police station. Georgetown recipients can pick up their cheques at the region's social services offices at 93 Main Street South. Monthly cheques will be available on the last day of the month, or if that falls on a weekend, the last Friday. Bi-monthly cheques will be available on the 15th of each month; again if that date happens to fall on the weekend cheques will be distributed on the nearest Friday. Daily payments will be available on a weekly basis in Georgetown Fridays between 10 p.m. and noon. Recipients are requested to bring the proper identification when picking up cheques.

# Local Baha'is appeal to UN for Iran 'persecution' probe

The Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of Halton Hills recently sent a cable to Dr. Kurt Waldheim, Secretary-General of the United Nations in New York, requesting that the United Nations investigate the plight of the Baha'i community in Iran and take steps to halt the persecution of the largest religious minority in Iran.

Two weeks ago, seven more Baha'is were tortured, then executed by firing squad at dawn June 14, in an attempt to force them to recant their faith.

The persecution has continued unabated despite the efforts of the Baha'is in every land for

the past two years to bring the plight of the Iranian Baha'i community to the attention of the authorities in Iran, including the Ayatollah Khomeini, and many countries and organizations throughout the world.

As with previous killings, these latest executions in Hamadan are part of a systematic plan by the fanatical elements of Iran to eradicate the Baha'i faith in the land of its birth.

The Baha'is are being executed on false charges, but the real reason is their membership in this law-abiding, non-political, non-violent community.

This is the second time that

the Baha'is of Halton Hills have attempted to intervene in the persecution of their fellow believers in Iran. Last year they sent a telegram to Ayatollah Khomeini requesting that he use his authority to stop the desecration of Baha'i holy places including the shrines and graveyards. This particular episode was well-documented on the CTV

# Getting to know duplicate bridge

East's bidding style will determine the course of the auction. Those who open their longer suit will have a problem after partner responds 1H. A 1NT rebid would suggest a full spade stopper and probably not quite so good a hand.

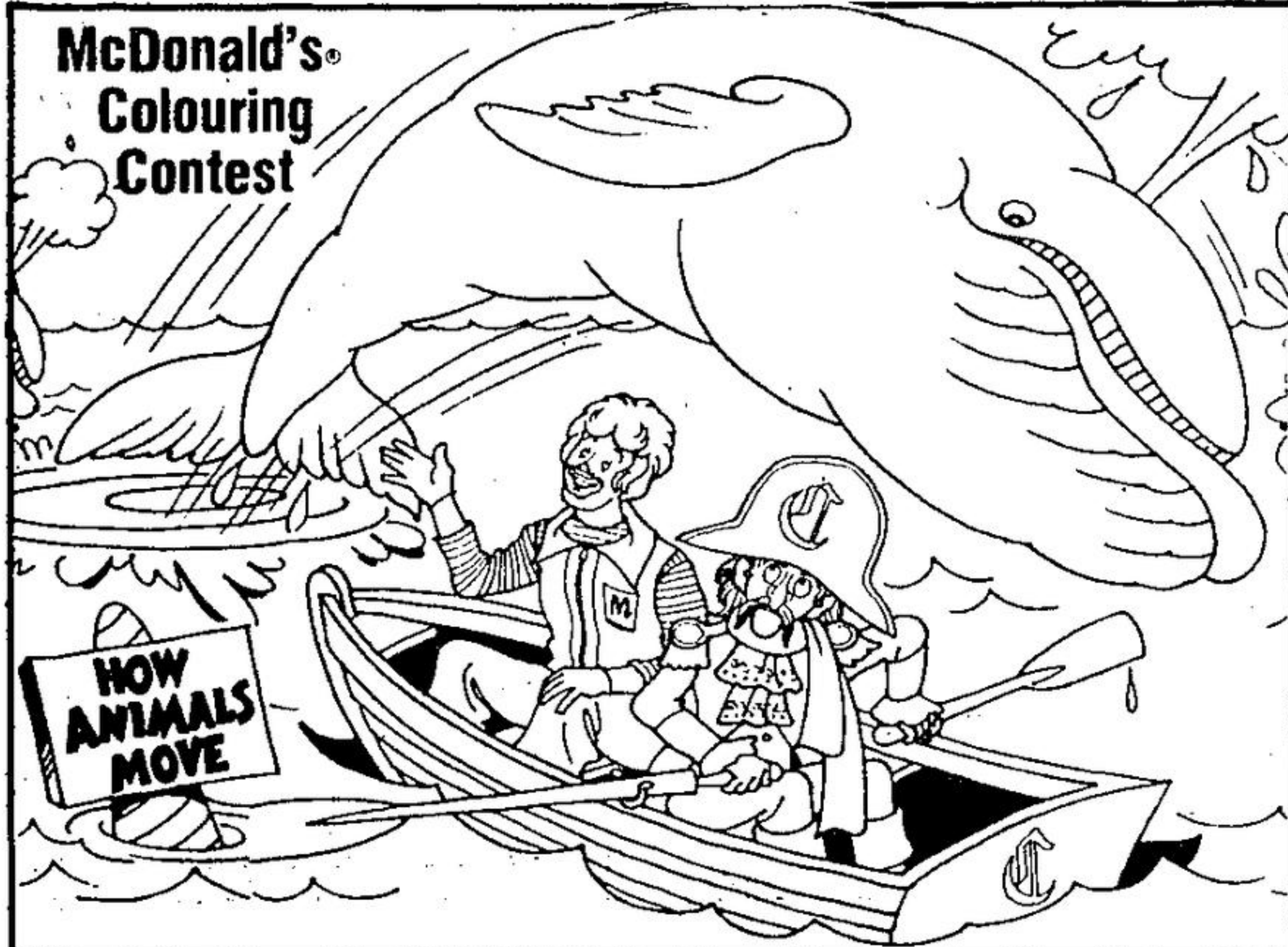
A 2 C rebid shows a six-card suit, and a reverse to 2 D shows a much better hand. The auction at many tables will go: N - Pass, E - 1 D, S - Pass, W - 1 H, N - 1 S, E - 2 C, S - 2 S, W - 3 C, all pass.

East now should collect a heart, 4 diamonds and 4 clubs. Should N-S compete to 3 S, they will come up with a top or bottom depending on whether E-W doubles or bids 4 C. 3 Spades should go down 2 tricks, (3 if declarer misplayed the spade Q).
