Modern science has come to the aid of many disabled and elderly people who wish to remain independent in their own homes. It is an "in-home" alert service which helps them maintain their usual life-style without relying on other people for constant supervision.

This useful device is a small transmitter which can be clipped to the clothing or hung around the neck of the wearer. It has a base unit which is connected to your telephone. To call for help, a button is pressed on the transmitter which sends a code signal to a 24-hour response centre where a file is kept on each subscriber.

## 'Medic-Alarm' saves lives

Georgetown's Ivan Crabtree is a very satisfied user of one of these devices called "Medic-Alarm". When he presses the button for help a computerized system immediately alerts a neighbor (in this case his daughter), the ambulance, and the hospital.

Recently, he had occasion to use the facility when he struck with a sudden seizure. In minutes, the neighbour and the ambulance were at his apartment. In Ivan's words, "They saved my life".

This summer, another one of these unique devices has become available in this area under the name of "Protect Alert".

Put brother, he didn't descend from us!"

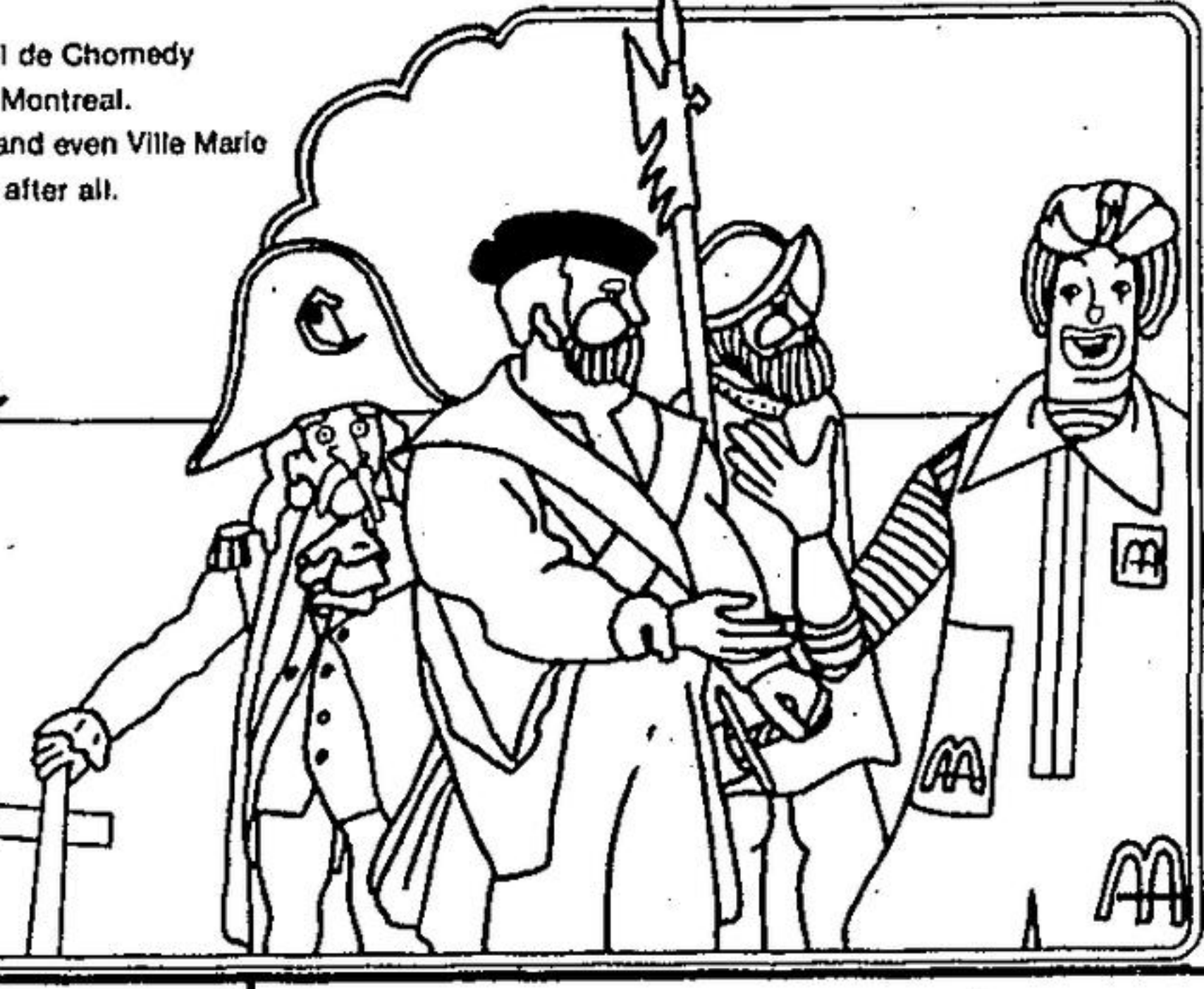


### A LITTLE LIGHT READING
