

# Sara smiles, demonstrates, for local gymnastic hopefuls at Camp

Sara Aggias, Georgetown's nationally ranked gymnast must have had a few chuckles after she performed a number of routines for a local Sports Camp at Georgetown's District High School last Friday.

'Are you married? Do you have a car?' were some of the questions Sara willingly obliged her young fans by answering.

The Cambridge Kips gymnast, who will be entering grade 13 at GDHS next fall, demonstrated to the Sports Camp some of her routines which she performs at a world class level.

Aggias is currently fifth-ranked in Canada and she has completed the first half of her world trials in which she placed fifth.

If she places fifth or better at the second world trial meet in Regina October 3 she will remain with the Canadian team and travel with them on the International circuit.

Recently, Sara was admitted to an elite class of

Canadian athletes when she was 'carded' on a national level. Previously she was carded on a provincial level, but a nationally carded athlete makes them eligible for federal financial assistance if they attend university. There are also other benefits in training allowed to a nationally carded athlete.

Last Friday Sara had some free time before she competed in Cambridge for their annual Can-Amra meet, so she decided to accept the Sports Camp offer to put on an exhibition.

The Can-Amra meet features a competition between a city of similar size to Cambridge in Michigan in such events as gymnastics, tennis, baseball and other sporting areas. Sara was outstanding in her four events last Saturday.

She placed first all-round while recording two firsts in the floor and beam, second on the vault and fifth on the bars. There were a total of 24 competitors at the gymnastics segment of the competition.

Since June Sara has not

been participating in meets, but has instead been perfecting and experimenting with her routines in her six-hour,

five day per week practice schedule. 'The summer is the best time to train, because you can learn new tricks,' she says.

Currently she has been perfecting some new twists

to her tumbling and vaulting routines. More emphasis has been placed on her uneven

bars routine, as she feels this is an area she can improve on.
