A cross-country or downhill skier interested in joining the Canadian Ski Patrol needs an intermediate skiing ability, time to take the first aid course and a desire to serve the skiing public.

The minimum age requirement is 16 years old for the Metro Toronto region and 18 for Northern areas.

Earl Haig Secondary School is located at 100 Princess Blvd., which is north of Sheppard Avenue running east of Yonge Street. Registration times are 7 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. each evening.

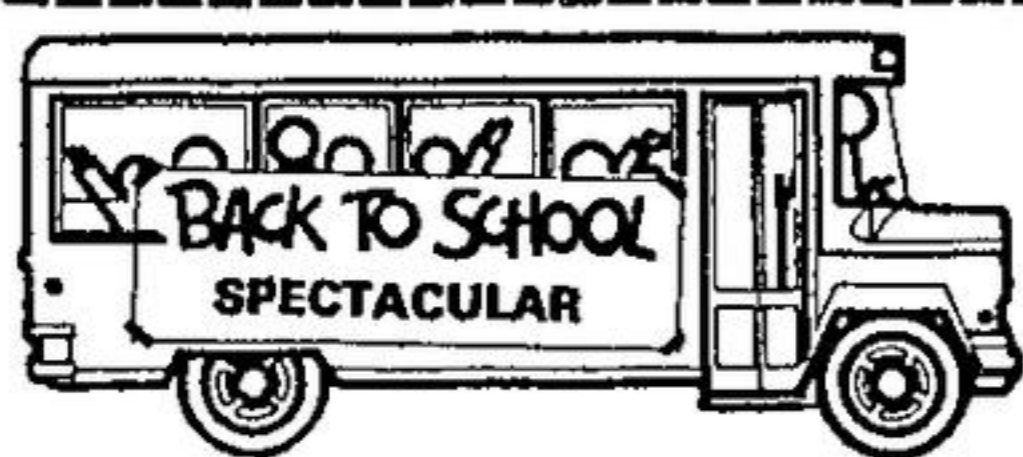
Poulstrup has also made a commitment to help sponsor the boys team and has already made arrangements to purchase a lottery licence to print 2,000 tickets.

player. The Forgotten team will be selling their raffle tickets within a week and a draw would be held perhaps in October and November.



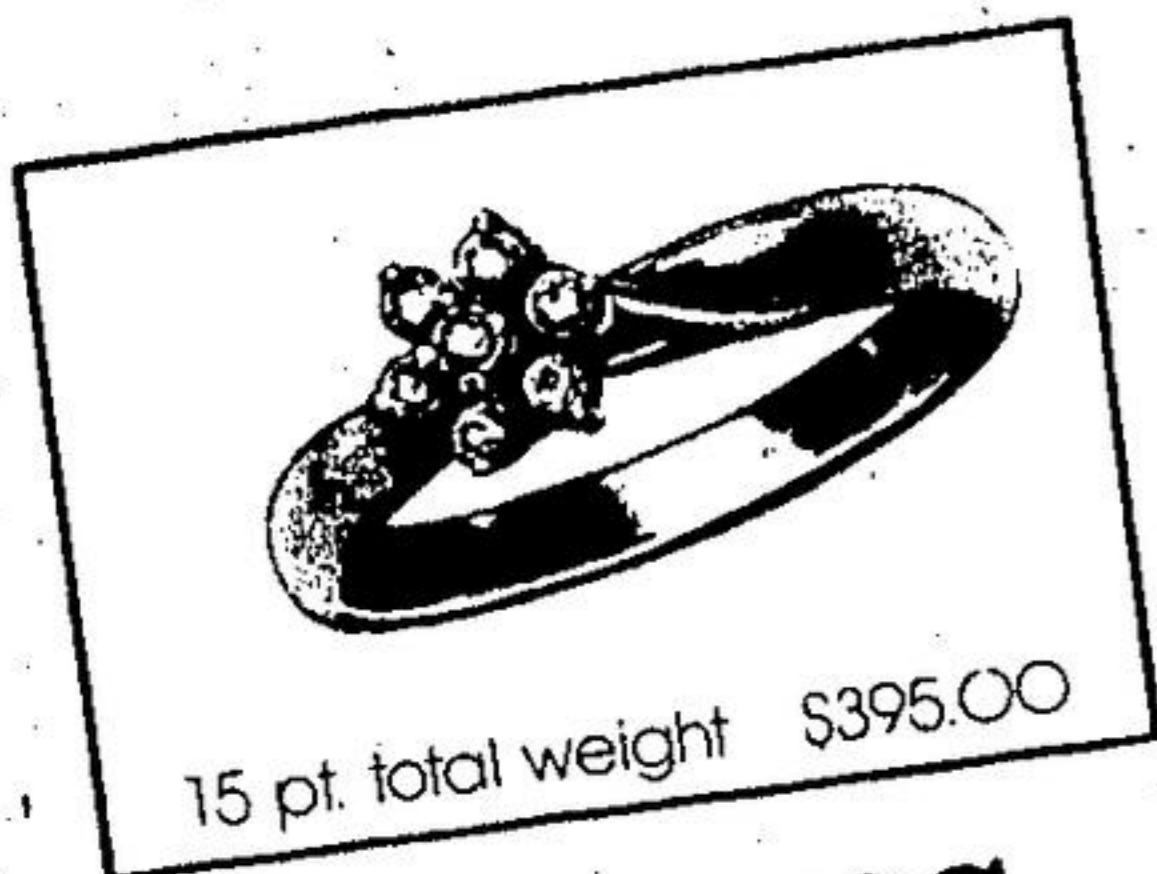
