The Summary of the Ontario Hunting regulations is now available. One feature of note is the picture of a Woman ARCHER on the cover.

The general hunting season opens at 12:01 tonight, or tomorrow if you wish. The date to be sure is September 26, 1981 and will run until December 20 for ducks.

Most hunters will be out after the high number of ducks available this year. Other seasons opening are: Pheasant, Luther marsh area 11, Pushilrsh area 13, Valense area 14. Beverly swamp area 15 Sept. 28th, our area (77) opens Oct. 21. Grouse, Areas 11, 13, 14, 15 as above opens Sept. 15th, area 77 on Sept. 26th.

Rabbits and Hares, 11, 13, 14, 15, Sept. 1st, area 77 October 21st. Squirrel, September 26.

Get a copy of the Summarry of the Regulations and remember it is only a summary. One mistake in the pamphlet is the Raccoon season is October 15th to DECEMBER 3, Not February 28 as in the summary. Where to go? Luther will be crowded but there will be lots of ducks. Hunt the streams, but all it takes is for one person to

be there ahead of you. Ponds, the same thing applies, but a little searching will turn up a place to get dinner. Don't forget to ask permission on private land, it is now the law.

While fishing with John Power last weekend, we tried some new lures John received from the west coast. Apparently some kind reader felt we did not know how to fish salmon, and sent along a few of his favorite lures. The Spring king "Disco Dancer" we lost right off on a

Chinook (King) salmon as was the case of the "Fire-

cracker". Maybe there is something to these lures after all.

Still there were no fish in the box, and the lake was rough. This is the last week of the Toronto Star Great Salmon Hunt, with the deadline at 12 noon next Sunday the 27th. A beautiful park right on the Credit River at Port Credit is the sight of the awards, and I will be in attendance and hope to
