### Fence halts brakeless car

Falling brakes caused \$3,000 damage to a vehicle Friday when the driver was unable to stop and ended up in a field on the south side of Steeles Avenue. The Georgetown man had originally been driving south along the Eighth Line when he approached an intersection. There was \$100 worth of damage to a wire fence.

### Deer crumples Mazda

A driver, unable to stop when a deer came out of the bush on the Seventh Line and stopped in the middle of the road, struck and killed the animal and caused \$1,500 damage to his 1977 Mazda.

### Close turn

There was \$2,000 damage done to a light standard on Mill Street Thursday when a trailer turning right onto Main Street from Mill Street struck the pole and knocked it down.

### Car meets hydro pole

Hitting a hydro pole can be expensive. A southbound vehicle on Weber Drive mounted the curb Saturday and struck a hydro pole causing \$1,200 damage to the car and \$500 damage to the pole. The driver was treated and released at Georgetown Memorial Hospital with minor injuries.

Commercial Shearing Ltd. on Commerce Crescent in Acton had filing cabinets pried open sometime Thursday night or early Friday morning. Unknown persons gained entry to the plant by removing a board that covered a broken window. Nothing was removed from the building, said Halton regional police.
