The Tory backbencher noted that the vote to allow Kurt Waldheim an unprecedented third term as secretary general has been rejected creating an impasse at the U.N. that must be rectified.

The Tory MP presented the Commons with a resolution demanding immediate reduction of the rate increase to "a realistic level" and action to correct inefficient postal operations which have resulted in regular post office deficits.




