In Figures and Freeskating Leah then placed 7th. Leah did a super job all round and her consistently good skating paid off. You had again to be in the first six to go to Sectionals, and to miss by one spot is tough to take. Congratulations, Leah, on a fine effort.

It was then off to Sectionals for Kirsten Mogg to compete in the Junior Ladies Division. After figures Kirsten placed 7th. In her short free skating

program, Kirsten missed a compulsory element dropping her to 8th position.

In this part of the program only one attempt at each element is allowed leaving no room for error. In the long free skating part of her program Kirsten skated extremely well and her beautiful artistic ability added much to her program.

However, this is an extremely strong competitive division and Kirsten was unable to better her position. Only the first four in this Division move on to Divisionals. Congratulations to all our skaters for their fine effort.

competition were David Watson in Junior Men, Darren Kemp in Novice Men and Lisa Smith in Junior Ladies.
