of Kingston, Jamaica, when I was there some years ago.)

INGREDIENTS 6 ripe bananas

I cup brown sugar

2 teaspoons lime or lemon juice

15 cup raisins 14 cup rum

METHOD

Sprinkle some of the brown sugar in bottom of a shallow baking pan, split the fruit lengthwise, lay in bottom of pan cut side down, place raisins on fruit and all over bottom of pan, sprinkle the rest of the sugar over fruit, add lemon-lime juice to rum, pour over everything. Bake in a slow oven (240 F) for about one hour. Watch that the brown sugar does not burn, and just judge the time for baking. Serve by pouring the liquid over the fruit. While cooking, if

juice evaporates, simply add a little more water. May be served with fowl, meats or as a dessert.

For the buffet table, CHEESE BALL

INGREDIENTS

I pound blue cheese

I pound cream cheese

¼ teasp. Worchester sauce 1/4 teasp. Tabasco sauce

1 cup chopped nuts (fine) your choice

METHOD

Cream the cheeses. Blend seasonings into mix. Add one third of nuts, then shape into a ball (maybe two) and roll in the remaining nuts to cover. Wrap the ball in clear plastic wrap and chill till set. Arrange crackers or fancy breads around the cheese balls on a large plate or fancy tray.


