# Geminis lose six players in 5-3 loss

Penalties again were seen as the demise of the Georgetown Gemini attack as they were edged by the Barrie Colts last Thursday night 5-3.

A called-back goal scored by the Gems' Guy Cormier didn't help matters for the Junior B club when the goal would have lifted the score to a 5-4 mark.

In a penalty-filled contest which saw six Gemini players suspended from anywhere from one to six games, Georgetown started slow in the first period, falling behind 3-1. Guy Cormier scored the lone Gemini goal in the first period from Mark Hamilton and Mike McMeney.

The Gems didn't gain their true momentum until the third period but continual penalties seemed to hurt the

Georgetown club.

In reference to future games without his six regular players, Gemini coach Bob Tost said jokingly that he would bring up the Georgetown Juvenile Rep team to play Sunday against Burlington and fill in a few gaps with his Gemini charges.

**SIX LOST**  
The loss of Mark Hamilton (three games), Kerry Fry (three games), Ed Dwyer (four games), Kevin Franks (six games) and Mike Tibbitts (one game) leaves the local club with no alternative but to have the first-place Georgetown Juveniles offer their services.

One of the reasons for the number of suspensions had to do with the quality of the

officiating, GM Bob Tost said.

Import defenceman Mike Corbley returned (finally) to the Gemini lineup and played an excellent game, according to Tost.

The status of Guy Cormier in his efforts to find employment are unclear at the moment according to the Gems and he may remain the rest of the season with Georgetown. Cormier was a key man in the Barrie game as he scored both the first and the disallowed goal.

Dean may have to miss the practising and games with the tournament All-Stars.

"We seemed to be able to get something going (in the way of an attack), but then we'd get ourselves right back in the penalty box," said GM Tost in summary of the Thursday game.

**FIRST GOAL:** Cormier's first period goal came mid-way through the

period with Barrie taking a quick 2-0 lead. A minute after Cormier's goal Barrie added another to end the first period at 3-1 for Barrie.

Georgetown scored their second goal of the game just three minutes into the second period on a power play drive by Mike Tibbitts, assisted by

Rob Vall. The 3-2 Barrie advantage stood until the 5:57 mark of the period when the Colts scored.

With five minutes left in the second period Barrie completed the scoring for the night and contented themselves with maintaining their

5-2 lead.

In the third period Bob Davey quickly unleashed a shot two minutes into the period on passes from Lance Doucette and Guy Cormier to complete the Gemini scoring except for Cormier's disallowed goal.
