A look at Intermediate A hockey

Intermediate "A" Hockey in Ontario four season's ago consisted of two divisions, the Georgian Bay Division, including teams from Collingwood, Owen Sound, Port Elgin and Orangeville.

The other division represented Port Colborne, Thor-

old, Dundas, and George-town. Following the 1978-79 season the league saw the demise of three of the eight teams: Orangeville, Thorold and Port Colborne.

During the summer months that followed the Senior "A" League also came to an end and the remaining teams, Barrie, Orillia and Cambridge were without a league in which to

The remaining teams in the Georgian Bay Intermediate "A" Hockey League then accepted applications from Barrie and Orillia, along with Georgetown and Dundas from the defunct southern Intermediate group. Cambridge went on to join the Continental Senior League.

League play for the '79-'80 season was very competitive in that any team could beat any other team, at any time, no game was the type that you could naturally assume who would win, and the fight for a final playoff spot went right to the last weekend of

regular season play. The first place Dundas Merchants defeated the third place Georgetown Raiders for the league championship, but bowed out of further competition in the series against the ODHA (Otawa District Hockey Associat-

The summer of 1980 saw the league adopt a new name "The OhA Major Intermediate "A" Hockey League". It was felt that the public relations of the league may improve if they didn't suggest the league pertained only to the Georgian Bay region. With the introduction of the new name and official letter-

head the league seemed to acquire a little more much needed publicity. Along with increased pub-lic relations the calibre of hockey in the league and additions of known hockey personalities to the league,

the 1960-'81 season was relatively successful.

A few of the noteable names in the league are people like: Darryl Sly -coach of the Collingwood Shipbuilders, formerly with the Toronto Maple Leafs, Vancouver Canucks and Minnesota North Stars, Jim Roberts - with the Owen Sound Greys played 4 years with the Minnesota Northstars, and was drafted in 1979 by the Winnipeg Jets.

Owen Sound coach John Lumley had spent 17 years in pro hockey with the American and Eastern leagues. Orilla has pro experience in the form of player-coach Jim Sherritt who spent two years with the Houston Arrows.

He was with them when they won the Avco Cup, and he centered the two Howes. He then played in Denver until they folded, Clyde Harr-is of Orillia played on Cana-da's Olympic Team.

The league once again saw a change in its member teams as the 1980 league champion Dundas Merchants moved on to the Continental Senior League and a new entry, The Midland Ath-letics joined the OHA Major Intermediate "A" Hockey League.

The 1980-'81 season wasn't as close, standings wise, with Midland just getting their feet wet, and Port Elgin experiencing trouble with recruiting players to their

Georgetown finished in first, and went on to become the league champions after ousting Owen Sound in the finals. Choose it
