

# Kris & Kelly hope for gold

World class dance skating duo Kris Barber of Glen Williams and Kelly Johnson of Willowdale can be seen on television this weekend as they compete in Canadian Figure Skating Championships which run Jan. 27-31.

Although Kris and Kelly finished with a silver medal last year at the Canadian championships, they must win a gold this year if they hope to compete at the World Figure Skating Championships.

Last year two teams were sent because of Canada's excellent performance in dance the year before.

The toughest competition could perhaps come from the skating pairs team of Rob McCall, 23 of Dartmouth, Nova Scotia and Tracy Wilson, 20 of Port Moody, British Columbia. Rob won the gold medal last year with another partner and he's only been with Tracy for six months. However, they've already won a bronze medal at their second international event.

neck injuries among young players, changes will have to be made. He feels strongly, however, that there is one additional point which should not be overlooked.

"It seems to me players have become totally fearless because of all the protective equipment they're wearing these days, and they're taking chances players in an earlier time wouldn't dream of," he says.

"So it may be a matter of teaching our youngsters that they cannot play with impunity, no matter how well protected they think they are."

Or, he suggests, the fault may be found to lie with the aggressive attitudes of minor league coaches, administrators, referees and even parents, who have been urging youngsters to take risks beyond their capabilities.
