Getting to know duplicate bridge

Odds have it that there are more chances for a bridge partnership to succeed at a partial than they would have succeeding at a game. Consequently, when three hands pass, and west has a hand containing a four-card major he should be aware of two things.

First, no one at the table has a 13 point hand. Knowing this, west is able to deduce that, at worst, his partnership has half the points available. West should reason that if he can find a 4 card spade suit in his partner's hand, they will have enough spades and strength to make 1 or 2 spades. He should also reason that if

his partner does not have the desired spade fit he must have three or four cards in the side suits making a try for 1 diamond or 1 no trump feasible.

The competitive bridge player must always be wary of THE HAND:

passing in fourth position with even eleven points and a four card major. This was the hand played by the Georgetown Duplicate Bridge Club members. Would you have bid in the West? Eight out of nine players did!

THE ANALYSIS:

This board is likely to be passed out unless West decides there is no such thing as a passed-out board in duplicate. If he does open, 1 heart seems best. The obvious reason is that the heart suit is twice as good as the spade suit but more important, since West does not intend to rebid, partner has two chances to respond at the one-level, one spade or one NT, thereby giving the E-W team maximum chance for a plus score. In fact, duplicate tactics sometimes create bidding connotations that should never occur in a normal game, so it wouldn't be too surprising to

see West open one diamond, which gives East three chances to respond at the one level. If West does open a red suit, his side will sail into a safe harbour of one spade, or, if pushed, a makeable two spade contract. The resulting score should be worth many, many matchpoints.

North-South winners at the Georgetown Bridge Club last Tuesday were Jim Sargent and Gundy Kisternaker. Second was Arthur Kwei and Peter Gostovic followed by Midge and Frank Hampshire.

East-West winners were Maureen Walker and Archie Daab followed by Gus Flesch and Fred Allen. Del Wallace
