

HUNGRY FOR NOSTALGIA



The four Foot children were out for a restaurant meal with their mom Friday night, and they didn't mind the wait. The four-day special prices offered by the Delrex Restaurant in the Georgetown Market Place attracted many hungry customers wanting to take advantage of meal values rolled back to 1960's prices. The owners of the restaurant were celebrating 22 years of business in Georgetown by offering customers their 1960 menu with prices intact, from Feb. 10 to 13.

Use your opening bid in bridge play defence

The opening lead can be a devastating card for defence in many circumstances. Often, declarer is defeated by a solid line of play by the defence but sometimes defence simply leads the one card that hands declarer an unmakeable contract on a silver platter.

Consider today's hand. When South stumbles into an ill-fated 4 S contract, and defender leads "a spade", declarer may call three rounds of spades to clear the suit, play a heart to the ace, ruff a heart and end up going down one.

THE ANALYSIS:
N-S have about a one in ten shot of making 4 spades, which are not very good odds, but any pair that gets that high will see ten tricks come rolling in effortlessly. More likely, however, South will declare a spade partial after opening with a weak two-bid or one spade (he must bid something in third seat). E-W will probably compete but the effort will prove futile since N-S are safe at whatever level they bid.

The play in 4 spades differs slightly from the play at a lower level. In game, South must bring in a diamond suit with only one loser and should therefore draw trumps before tackling diamonds. In a partial, declarer can afford to lose two diamonds and should play a diamond to the jack as soon as he gains the lead. If the diamonds are breaking 4-2 and

the defenders fail to lead trumps after winning the first diamond, South will be able to ruff his fourth diamond with dummy's J of spades. These plans are abandoned when West puts up an honour on the first diamond lead.

The North-South winners at the Georgetown Club last Tuesday were Harry Arbic and Grant Beal. Second place was held by Del Wallace and Art Norris and Helen Fleming and Midge Hampshire were third.

The East-West winners were Peter Gostovic and Brian Ayer followed by Jackie Forsell and Ron Glide. John Flanagan and Peter Kakra were third.

The club guarantees individuals a partner if required.

However, if West begins with a low diamond which South chooses to duck on the board, declarer will quickly run ten tricks and many match points will be earned. The diamond suit is critical in the deal. This was the hand played by the Georgetown Duplicate Bridge Club last Tuesday.
