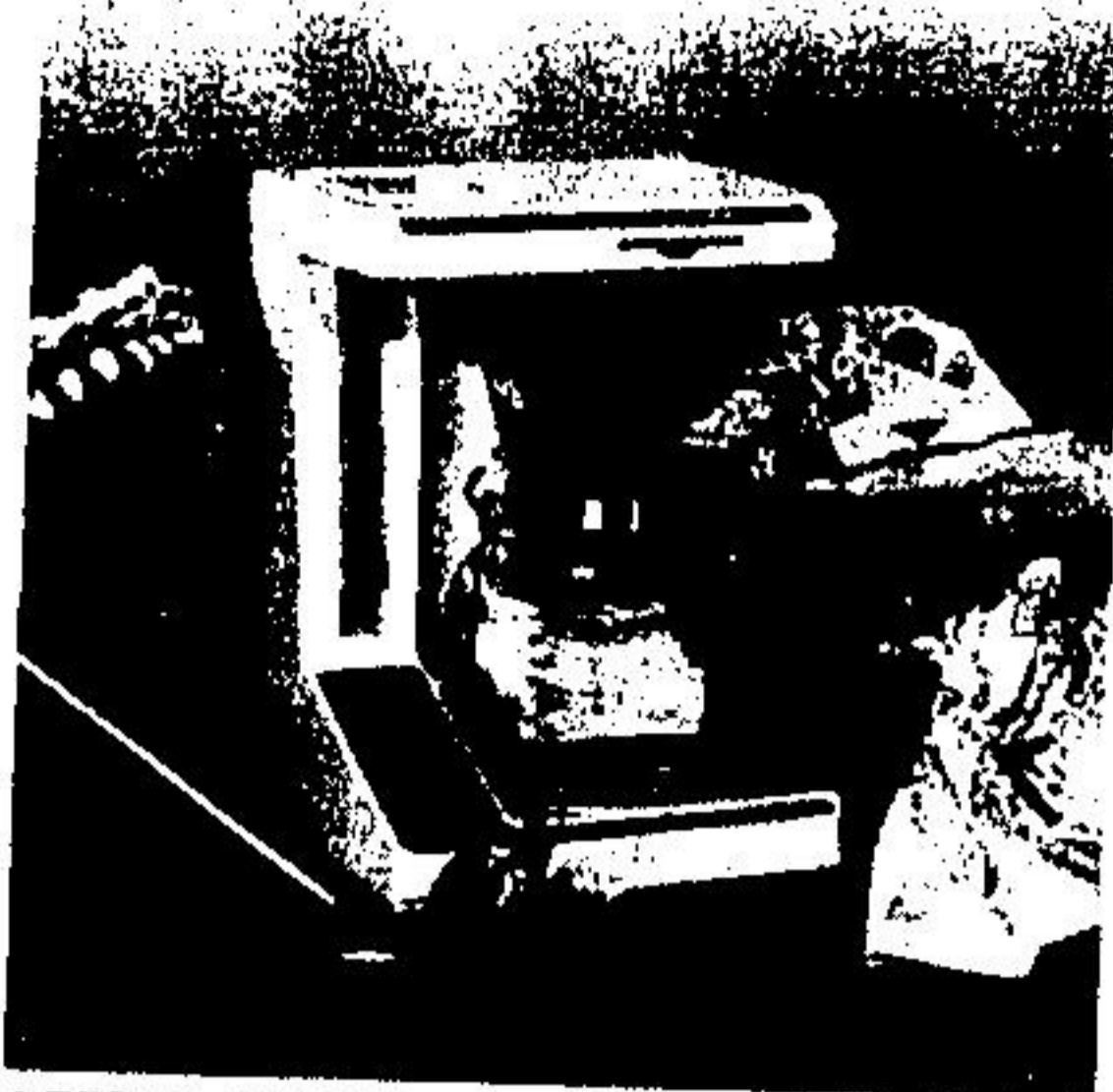


## Great gift idea: brew up a future for two
